COMMISSIONERS' PROCEEDINGS  
SPECIAL MEETING

The Board of Commissioners met July 22, 1946 at 8:00 p. m., all members present, for the final hearing and revision of the County Budget for 1946-47 starting July 1, 1946 and ending June 30, 1947. There were in attendance Day P. Espy and Joe Fraher representing the Carbon County Memorial Hospital, Robert R. Lines, Union Pacific Tax Agent, Harold M. Johnson, Union Pacific Attorney, R. A. Hakala, Deputy County Assessor, Margaret A. Larsen, County Treasurer, and Ruth Petersen, Deputy County Clerk.

A motion was made by Commissioner Gooldy, seconded by Cheesbrough and unanimously carried whereby the following revisions were made.

It was recommended that the Cash Reserve Fund for the County General be increased from \$65000 to \$70000. It was also recommended that the Carbon County Memorial Hospital Reserve Fund request of \$20000 be reduced to \$15000. The Board of Commissioners decided to increase the Cash Reserve for the County General Fund to \$70000 and retain \$20000 in the Memorial Hospital Reserve Fund.
