COMMISSIONERS' PROCEEDINGS
SPECIAL MEETING

The Board of Commissioners met August 5, 1946 at 10:00 a. m., all members present, together with Deputy County Assessor R. A. Hakala, for the purpose of fixing the Tax Levies for and within Carbon County for the year 1946-47 in compliance with Chapter 110 of the Session Laws of Wyoming, 1945.

Having received from the State Board of Equalization notice that the assessed valuation of Carbon County for the year 1946-1947 has been found to be \$33,306,264.00, the Deputy County Assessor advised the Board of the assessed valuation of each of the various municipalities and school districts within the County, and the Board proceeded to fix the levies upon the assessed property of Carbon County for the year 1946-1947 as follows:




