COMMISSIONERS PROCEEDINGS

SPECIAL MEETING

The Board of Commissioners met at 10:00 A. M. all present, Eugene McCarthy presiding for the purpose of hearing and receiving protests and claims for damages on the proposed Dixon-Savery road and to transact other County business.

A motion was made by Commissioner Gooldy, seconded by Cheesbrough and unanimously carried whereby the following resolution was adopted.

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, The Board of Commissioners at their regular meeting held August 7, 1946 made a resolution to locate a road known as the Dixon-Savery Road, being described as follows:

Commencing at a point which is on the east corporate limits of Dixon which point is N. 89° 11' E., 599.7 feet of a point which is S. 89° 28' E. 298.0 feet from the section corner common to Sections 4, 5, 8 and 9, T. 12 N., R. 90 W.; thence in an easterly direction a distance of 4.55 miles to the town of Savery, and

WHEREAS, the date of hearing for protests and claims for damages was set for September 9, 1946 and the following claims for damages were allowed and paid:
