CENTENNIAL-SARATOGA ROAD

RESOLUTION TO LOCATE ROAD

Whereas, public necessity requires that the following road be established,

Now, therefore, be it resolved by the Board of County Commissioners that the following described road be located and established as follows, to wit:

Project No. F. H. 12 1-1, G-3

County No. Cb-5

A. F. E.

NOTICE OF LOCATION OF PUBLIC ROAD

TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

The Board of County Commissioners of Carbon County, Wyoming have decided to locate a road to be known as Centennial - Saratoga commencing at a point in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec. 12, T16N R82W of the 6th P. M. Wyoming, which point is N 51°08'W.775.9 feet from a point which is N 4°06' E 1185.6 feet from the S. E. corner of said section 12; THENCE in a general southeasterly direction thru Section 12, T16N R82W, Sections 7,18,17,20,29,28,27,26 and 25 of T16N R81W and Sections 30 and 29, T16N R80W to a point in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  said Section 29, T16N R80W, said point being S88°06' E 475 feet from a point which is S 16°51' W 440.5 feet from the West  $\frac{1}{4}$  corner of said Section 29, T16N R80W.

The proposed location and width of right of way required are set forth in detail on Map on file with the County Clerk and may be examined at his office.

All objections thereto and claims for damages must be filed in writing with the County Clerk of said County before noon on the 11th day of March A.D. 1946, or such road will be established without reference to such objections or claims for damages.

Adopted and passed this 5th day of February, 1946.

The Board unanimously confirmed the appointment of Anna K. Goffar as Deputy County Clerk.
