SPECIAL MEETING

The Board of County Commissioners met August 4, 1947, at 10:00 a. m., all members present, together with County Assessor Wm. A. Johnson and Deputy County Assessor R. A. Hakala, for the purpose of fixing the ¹⁹⁴⁷⁻⁴⁸ ^{31-512 Wyo Comp} Tax Levies for and within Carbon County for the year 1947-48 in compliance with Chapter 110 of the Session ^{Statutes of 1945} Laws of Wyoming, 1945.

Having received from the State Board of Equalization notice that the assessed valuation of Carbon ¹⁹⁴⁷⁻⁴⁸ ^{acting} County for the year 1947-48 has been found to be \$33,736,752.00, the County Assessor advised the Board of the assessed valuation of each of the various municipalities and school districts within the County, and the ¹⁹⁴⁷⁻⁴⁸ Board proceeded to fix the levies upon the assessed property of Carbon County for the year 1947-48, as follows:
