

February 6, 1947

The Board resumed its session February 6, 1947 at 10:00 a. m. all members present.

The members of the Hospital Board met with the Commissioners and discussed general conditions at the Hospital.

The Fair Board met with the Commissioners relative to the use of the Fair buildings for other than fair purposes. No definite conclusion was reached regarding this matter. A discussion was had relative to construction of a building for use as a sales ring, 4-H Club activities and a recreation center. This matter was postponed pending further investigation.

CERTIFICATE OF PURCHASE: No. 3376 was ordered cancelled by the Board on account of prior sale of the acreage described in this certificate, being 8.25 acres in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 1, Township 14 North, Range 84 West of the 6th P. M. This land was assessed under the D. L. Condon Estate.

A motion was made by Commissioner Sullivan, seconded by McCarthy and unanimously carried whereby the following resolution was adopted.

WHEREAS, it is necessary that counsel be employed to perfect said appeal and try said cases in conjunction with the Attorney General of the State of Wyoming;


