TRANSFER OF FUNDS:

In compliance with Section 20-811 of the Municipal Budget Act, Wyoming Compiled Statutes of 1945, as amended in the Session Laws of 1947, a Notice of Public Hearing on the proposed transfer of \$1600.00 from the County General Cash Reserve Fund to the District Court Fund and \$500.00 from the County Fair Cash Reserve Fund to the County Fair Fund was published on April 20, 1948.

There being no protests, the following resolution was adopted on motion by Commissioner Sullivan and seconded by Commissioner McCarthy.

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the District Court Fund has become depleted by reason of unexpected court costs, and,

WHEREAS, the County Fair Fund has become depleted by reason of unexpected costs of holding the County Fair;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the sum of \$1600.00 be appropriated from the County General Cash Reserve Fund to supplement the District Court Fund, and the sum of \$500.00 be appropriated from the County Fair Reserve Fund to supplement the County Fair Fund.

A delegation from the Platte Valley met with the Board and requested that a sum of \$1200.00 be appropriated for a Home Demonstration Agent in the 1948-49 budget. This request was referred to the County Agent and Budget Officer for consideration in compiling the 1948-49 budget.

Mr. J. E. Graham, Engineer from the Wyoming Highway Department, met with the Board and the land owners along the Medicine Bow-Rawlins Highway, Project No. F.I. 221 (2) to further discuss fencing, underpasses and other problems connected with the proposed re-routing of Highway 30 between Medicine Bow and Dana.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
