Beginning at Station 16467 of the Russell Road, running easterly to the east line of Section 11, Township 12 North Range 90 West of the 6th P.M.

It is expressly understood that Carbon County is hereby relieved of any claim for damages or responsibility for maintenance of Portions 1 and 2 of the old county road described above as exceptions from the abandonment.

RESOLUTION

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Carbon County, Wyoming, that a county road be established in Section 11, Township 12 North, Range 90 West of the 6th P.M., running from the new state highway between Dixon and Savery to the old county road between Dixon and Savery, being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the south boundary of the highway right-of-way at a point located N. 8°40' W. 722 feet from the east quarter corner of Section 11, Township 12 North of Range 90 West;
thence S. 26°02' W. 410 feet;
thence S. 44°47' W. 517 feet;
thence S. 25°45' W. 408 feet;
thence S. 5°55' W. 332 feet;
at which point the proposed new road, to be known as the Russell Road, connects with the old county road between Dixon and Savery.

The total length of the new road is 1667 feet and the right-of-way required is 60 feet in width, being 30 feet on each side of the center line described above.
