RAWLINS-MEDICINE BOW ROAD, Project FI 221(4)

At a special meeting of the Commissioners held on Feb. 5, 1949 a claim for damages was presented by C.A. Brimmer, representing Mrs. Jarda Nelson of the Andy Nelson Sheep Co. This was taken under consideration by the Board and the State Highway Department and an agreement reached whereby Mrs. Nelson was paid for 83.4 acres of land contained in the new Right-of-Way at \$3.00 per acre making a total of \$250.20. There being no further protests on this road a motion was made by Commissioner Sullivan, seconded by McCarthy and unanimously carried whereby the ~~shameless and unscrupulous~~ following resolution was adopted:

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RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners have accepted the claim for damages presented by C. A. Brimmer Attorney for Mrs. Jarda Nelson of the Andy Nelson Sheep Co. in the amount of \$250.20,

Now THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the proposed Rawlins-Medicine Bow Road, Project FI 221(4) be established and that the Wyoming Highway Department be notified of this action.

Several matters of routine County business were disposed of, after which the Board adjourned.
