The Board of Commissioners met at 9:30 O'Clock A.M., all members present, together with highway engineer, Talcott Moore, for the purpose of discussing the farm-to-market road program and future work on the Sage Creek Road. A motion was made by Commissioner Salisbury, seconded by Cheesbrough and unanimously carried whereby the following resolutions were adopted:

BRUSH CREEK ROAD RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Carbon, is desirous of taking advantage of the provisions of Chapter 99, Session Laws of Wyoming, 1951, by cooperating with the State Highway Commission of Wyoming in the improvement of a county road, the location and extent of which is as follows:

The road known as the Brush Creek Road extending from the State Highway known as FAS 14 Southerly to the Leonard Bridge over the North Platte River.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by said Board:
THAT the Board enter into a written agreement with said Commission covering said improvement in accordance with a contract therefore, now submitted to said Board by said Commission, which agreement is hereby approved and ordered filed in the office of the County Clerk of said county; that the chairman of said Board and the County Clerk of said county be, and they are hereby authorized and directed to execute said contract on behalf of said Board.

RAWLINS SAGE-CREEK ROAD RESOLUTION
