COMMISSIONERS' PROCEEDINGS  
TAX LEVY MEETING

The Board of County Commissioners met August 4, 1952, at 2:00 p.m., Cheesbrough and McCarthy present, Salisbury absent, together with County Assessor, Wm. A. Johnson and Deputy County Assessor, R. A. Hakala, for the purpose of fixing the Tax Levies for and within Carbon County for the year 1952-53 in compliance with Chapter 32-512, Wyoming Compiled Statutes of 1945.

Having received from the State Board of Equalization notice that the assessed valuation of Carbon County for the year 1952-53 has been found to be \$42,506,816.00, the County Assessor advised the Board of the assessed valuation of each of the various municipalities and school districts within the County, and the Board proceeded to fix the levies upon the assessed property of Carbon County for the year 1952-53, as follows:
