TRANSFER OF FUNDS FROM CASH RESERVE: In compliance with Section 20-811 of the Municipal Budget Act, W.C.S., 1945, as amended in the Session Laws of 1947, a Notice of Public Hearing on the proposed transfer of \$1000.00 from the Cash Reserve Fund was published on December 22, 1951.
