COMMISSIONER'S PROCEEDINGS

SPECIAL MEETING

The Board of Commissioners met at 1:30 P.M., there being present Commissioners Cheesbrough and Robertson, Salisbury absent.

The motion was made by Commissioner Robertson, seconded by Cheesbrough and carried whereby the following resolution was adopted:

R E S O L U T I O N

WHEREAS, The Board of Commissioners of Carbon County, Wyoming, on the 7th day of January, 1953, did adopt a resolution declaring their intention to establish a road to be known as the Rawlins - Medicine Bow road, Wyoming Project I - 221 (6), as follows:

Commencing at a point on the north boundary of Section 30, T. 21 N., R. 83 W. from which the northeast corner of said section 30 bears easterly a distance of 2381.4 feet; thence running in a southwesterly direction through Section 30, T. 21 N., R. 83 W.; Sections 25, 26, 35, 36, 34, 33, 32 and 31, T. 21 N., R. 84 W., and Section 36, T. 21 N., R. 85 W., to a point on the west boundary of Section 36, T. 21 N., R. 85 W., from which point the northwest corner of said section 36 bears N. 0°41' E. a distance of 1618.6 feet, and

WHEREAS, All land owners and all persons claiming any interest in lands crossed were given due notice as prescribed by law, and

WHEREAS, Claims were filed by the various land owners as follows:

Albin Peterson SW $\frac{1}{4}$  and NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec. 25, T. 21 N., R. 84 W. Claim for \$10 per acre for 22.1 acres, a total of \$221.00.

Fauze Nassif SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 25, T. 21 N., R. 84 W. Claim for \$10 per acre for 19.9 acres, a total of \$199.00.

Union Pacific Railroad Co. Section 35, T. 21 N., R. 84 W. Claim for \$10 per acre for 43.8 acres, a total of \$438.00

Leo Sheep Co. Sections 33 and 31, T. 21 N., R. 84 W. Claim for \$4.00 per acre for 73.4 acres, a total of \$293.60. Right of way from Walcott Junction to west end of project to be fenced with woven wire on north side and barbed wire on south side, with agreement for woven wire on the south side where the fence comes close to the ridge if it becomes necessary in the future. Necessary wire gates, crossings and approaches. Old highway to be left intact except that blacktop and surfacing may be removed.

Wyoming Timber Company SW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 36, T. 21 N., R. 85 W. Claim for \$10 per acre for 9.7 acres, a total of \$97.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED: That the claims as listed above are hereby approved and ordered paid, and that the road as described above and shown in detail on a map on file with the County Clerk is hereby declared established, and that a plat of same be placed in the road plat book with proper notations of the proceedings of this Board in relation to the establishment.
