## PROPOSED CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT NO. 1

"No moneys derived from fees, excises, or license taxes levied by the State and exclusive of registration fees and licenses or excise taxes imposed by a county or municipality, relating to registration, operation or use of vehicles on public highways, streets or alleys, or to fuels used for propelling such vehicles, shall be expended for other than cost of administering such laws, statutory refunds and adjustments allowed therein, payment of highway obligations, costs for construction, reconstruction, maintenance and repair of public highways, county roads, bridges, and streets, alleys and bridges in cities and towns, and expense of enforcing state traffic laws."

This proposed amendment to the Constitution of the State of Wyoming will dedicate all gasoline and other road user's taxes to construction and maintenance of streets and highways, costs of administration and enforcement of State Traffic Laws.

## PROPOSED CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT NO. 2

Proposal to amend Section 17, Article 5, of said Constitution to read as follows:

"Article 5, Section 17, The judges of the supreme and district courts shall receive such compensation for their services as may be prescribed by law, which compensation shall not be increased or diminished during the term for which a judge shall have been elected, and the salary of a judge of the supreme or district court shall be as may be prescribed by law; provided, however, that when any legislative increase or decrease in the salary of the

Justices or Judges of such courts whose respective terms of office do not expire at the same time, has heretofore or shall hereafter become effective as to any member of such court, it shall be effective from such date as to each of the members thereof."

This proposed amendment to the Constitution of the State of Wyoming allows the Legislature by law to fix during their terms, the salaries of Justices and Judges of the Supreme Court and the District Courts, so that each justice and each judge performing similar duties will receive like salaries.

PROPOSED CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT NO. 3

Proposal to amend Section 5, Article 16 of said Constitution to read as follows:

"Article 16, Section 5. No city, town or village, or any subdivision thereof, or any subdivision of any county of the state of Wyoming, shall, in any manner, create any indebtedness exceeding two per centum on the assessed value of the taxable property therein; provided, however, that any city, town or village may be authorized to create an additional indebtedness, not exceeding 4 per centum on the assessed value of the taxable property therein as shown by the last preceding general assessment, for the purpose of building sewerage therein; and provided further, that any school district may be authorized to create an additional indebtedness, not exceeding eight (8) per centum on the assessed value of the taxable property therein as shown by the last preceding general assessment, for the purpose of the erection or enlargement of school buildings therein; debts contracted for supplying water to such city or town are excepted from the operation of this section."

Our State Constitution at present provides that the overall debt limit of school districts shall not exceed six (6) per centum on the assessed value of the taxable property therein for the purpose of erection or enlargement of school buildings. This proposed amendment, if adopted, would increase the overall limit of indebtedness for such purposes to ten (10) per centum.
