HANNA HOSPITAL - A delegation of Hanna and Rawlins residents met with the Board to discuss ways and means of assisting in financing the Hanna hospital. Upon receiving legal advise it was decided that there is no provision in the law which allows any donation or other money from the County for assisting or maintaining a second County Hospital.

WATER COMMISSIONER: Application for position of Water Commissioner for District No. 6 was received from Ralph E. Platt. An application from Reed Higby for position of Water Commissioner for District No. 7 was received by the Board. These applications had been endorsed by W. J. Knowlton, Supt. of Water Division No. 1, and were approved by the Board of Commissioners, subject to final approval by the Governor of Wyoming.

The Board resumed its session, Cheesbrough and Robertson present, Salisbury absent.

MALT BEVERAGE LICENSE and TRANSFER OF LIQUOR LICENSE: There being no protest entered Liquor License No. 56 was transferred to McQuay and Sims of McFadden, Wyoming. Jack and Mattie Hoth former owners of License No. 56, have filed with the County Clerk an assignment of all right, title and interest in this license which expires on October 6, 1954.

Malt Beverage License No. 165, was granted to Gertrude M. Anderson, Walcott, Wyoming for the sum of \$100.00.

Malt Beverage License No. 166, was granted to Dee J. Gillilan, Ft. Steele, Wyoming for the sum of \$100.00.

BOND of Dean Robinson, Rawlins, Wyo., Treasurer of Predatory Animal Board in Carbon County was approved in the amount of \$5000.00.

State-County & Farm to Market priorities for 1954 were selected as follows by the Board of Commissioners and the Wyoming Highway Department was duly notified.

- 1- Hanna-Lee Road
- 2- Sinclair-Platte River Road
- 3- Spring & Cow Creek Gravel stock piling
- 4- Ft. Steele-Hiway- 30 connecting road
- 5- Sinclair-Seminole Dam - second section

MONTHLY REPORTS of County Officers were approved and placed on file.

A motion was made by Robertson, seconded by Cheesbrough and carried whereby the following resolution was adopted.

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Carbon, is desirous of taking advantage of the provisions of Chapter 99, and/or Chapter 118, Session Laws of Wyoming, 1951, by cooperating with the State Highway Commission of Wyoming in the improvement of County roads, the location and extent of which is as follows:

SINCLAIR-PLATTE RIVER ROAD

Commencing at a point on the Sinclair - Seminole Dam Road Approximately 1/2 mile north of the Town of Sinclair; thence in an easterly direction approximately 6 1/2 miles to the Sinclair Recreation Park — beginning at a point on the east R/W line of the Sinclair - Seminole Dam Road which is N. 50° 37' E. 3411.3 ft. from the S.W. Corner of Sec. 16, T. 21 N., R. 86 W. of the 6th Principal Meridian, to the east line of Sec. 6, T. 21 N., R. 85 W. Work to consist of: Grade, drain, base coarse surfacing, oil mat and seal coat.

30
FT. STEELE-HI-WAY/CONNECTING ROAD

Commencing on U. S. Highway No. 30; thence in a northerly direction 1.8 miles to the Town of Ft. Steele, located in Township 21 North, Range 85 West. Work to consist of: Grade, drain, base coarse surfacing, oil mat and seal coat.

SINCLAIR-SEMINOLE DAM - SECOND SECTION

Commencing at the north end of Sinclair-Seminole Dam Project, Section 1, thence running in a north-easterly direction approximately 3 1/2 miles. Work to consist of: Grade, drain, base coarse surfacing, oil mat and seal coat.


NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by said Board:

THAT the Board enter into a written agreement with said Commission covering said improvement in accordance with a contract therefor, now submitted to said Board by said Commission, which agreement is hereby approved and ordered filed in the office of the County Clerk of said county; that the chairman of said Board and the County Clerk of said county be, and they are hereby authorized and directed to execute said contract on behalf of said Board.


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
