TRANSFER OF FUNDS FROM CASH RESERVE: In compliance with Section 2-811 of the Municipal Budget Act, W.C.S., 1945, as amended in the Session Laws of 1947, a Notice of Hearing on the proposed transfer of funds from the Cash Reserve Fund was April 4, 1957 as follows:

A motion was made by Cheesbrough and seconded by Jackson whereby the following resolution was adopted to-wit:

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the above budgets have become depleted due to unanticipated costs.

IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the County Budget Officer and County Treasurer be authorized to transfer the above mentioned funds.

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SPRING CREEK VOTING DISTRICT No. 12, Precinct No. 2, consolidation with Saratoga, District No. 11 Precinct No. 1. A petition was received by the voters of Spring Creek requesting the above consolidation in the interest of economy. The Board approved this application.

ELK MOUNTAIN-MEDICINE BOW RANGER STATION ROAD.

On March 5, 1957, the Board of County Commissioners passed a resolution to publish a NOTICE OF LOCATION OF PUBLIC ROAD, which appeared in the Rawlins Daily Times on March 12, 19 and 26th, the date for hearing of protests and claims for damages being set before noon on May 8th, 1957. Road

No protests or claims for damages to establishment of this road have been filed; the following request from C. A. McKee was filed to wit:

"Kindly change the description of the right of way through my land to read; 100 ft. westward from the eastern edge of the east borrow pit. This will save my grove of trees in event of future widening of the road, which will also require another cattle guard for the additional width."

The request of Mr. C. A. McKee is hereby validated.

A motion was made by Commissioner Jackson, seconded by Cheesbrough and carried whereby the following resolution and Right of Way Certificate was adopted to wit:

RESOLUTION

I, George R. Salisbury, Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners of Carbon County, Wyoming, do hereby certify that the below described premises were officially taken and established as a Highway right of way by said County on the 8 day of May, 1957, by virtue of a resolution duly passed by said Board and recorded in Book 11 at page 43 of the county commissioners' proceedings of said County. The right of way is located over and across the following described lands located in the County of Carbon and State of Wyoming, to wit:

The highway right of way being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the West line of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 20, Twp. 20 N., Range 80 W., 1010' N. of the SW Corner of said fraction; thence on a curve right to tangent southwesterly through said Section 20; thence southerly through sections 29 and 32 Twp. 20 N. Range 80 W; thence southerly through sections 5, 8, 17, 20, 21, 28 and 33, Twp. 19, N. Range 80 W.; thence southeasterly through sections 4, 9 and 16, Twp. 18N., Range 80 W. to a point on the south line of said section 16, 1265 ft. more or less, east of the south quarter corner thereof, said route more particularly shown on a map on file with the County Clerk of Carbon County.

Pursuant to Section 3 (e), Chapter 181, Session Laws of Wyoming, 1953, the Board of County Commissioners of Carbon County, State of Wyoming, has heretofore authorized the chairman of said Board by resolution, recorded in Book 11 at page 43, of the county commissioners' proceedings of said County, to make, execute, and seal the foregoing certificate.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, we, the Chairman of the said Board of County Commissioners and the County Clerk of said County, have hereunto set our hands and affixed the seal of the said Board of County Commissioners this 8th day of May, A.D., 1957.

ABANDONMENT - OLD HIGHWAY NO. 30 between Medicine Bow-Hanna to a point near the Palm Livestock Company Headquarters west of Hanna. The Board discussed and decided to request the Wyoming Highway Department to include that portion of old Highway No. 30 from a point one and one half miles west of Hanna (being the Palm Livestock Company Headquarters), eastward to the junction of the new and old Highway No. 30, into the Wyoming Highway Secondary System, for the benefit of Ranchers and Residents in the vicinity of Hanna and Elmo.
