COMMISSIONERS PROCEEDINGS  
REGULAR MEETING

The Board of Commissioners met at 10:00 A.M., all members present, Salisbury, Chairman.

The Minutes of meetings held June 3, 4, 9 and 17th were read and approved.

ELECTION DISTRICTS

In compliance with Section 31-106 of Election Laws of Wyoming 1951 the Board established the following election district and polling precincts.

## DISTRICT NO. 1 - Rawlins

Beginning at a point on Section line between Section 19 and 20, and proceeding in a northeasterly direction <sup>Tenth</sup> paralleling the Railroad to the junction of <sup>Seventh</sup> Street and Front Street, thence running north on <sup>Seventh</sup> Street to Buffalo Street, thence northeasterly on Buffalo Street to section line between Section 15 and 16, thence south to section line between Section 21 and 28, thence west to southwest corner of Section 20, thence north to point of beginning, all in Township 21, Range 87.

## DISTRICT NO. 2 - RAWLINS

<sup>Tenth</sup> Beginning at intersection of <sup>Seventh</sup> Street and Buffalo Street, thence along Buffalo Street in northeasterly direction to section line between Section 15 and 16, thence north to the northeast corner of Section 16, thence west to a point on the section lines between Sections 8 and 17, thence south on <sup>Tenth</sup> East side of <sup>Seventh</sup> Street to the point of beginning, with exception of McGee-Murphy Garage at SE corner of 7th Street and Lincoln Highway which is to be in District No. 3, Precinct No. 1, all in Township 21, Range 87.

And beginning at the northeast corner of Township 24 N., Range 86 W., running thence west along the township line between townships 24 and 25, and to the northwest corner of Township 24 N., Range 89 W.; thence south along the west boundary line of Carbon County to the southwest corner of Township 20 North Range 89 W., thence west on the township line between Townships 19 and 20 to the range line between ranges 90 and 91; thence south on the range line between 90 and 91 to the southwest corner of Township 16 North Range 90 W.; thence east on the township line between Townships 15 and 16 to the line between Ranges 87 and 88 W.; thence north on the range line between Ranges 87 and 88 to the southwest corner of Township 18 North Range 87 W.; thence east on the township line between Townships 17 and 18 to the southeast corner of Township 18 North Range 86 W.; thence north on the range line between Ranges 85 and 86 to the Township line between Townships 18 and 19; thence east on said township line to the range line between Ranges 84 and 85; thence north on range line between Ranges 84 and 85 to the Township line between Townships 19, 20; thence west on the township line between Townships 19 and 20 to the range line between Ranges 85 and 86; thence north on the range line between Ranges 85 and 86 to the northeast corner of Township 24 North, Range 86 West, to the place of beginning, except and omitting Township 21 North, Range 86 West 6th P.M., also Townships 22, 23 and 24 North Range 86 West and  $\frac{1}{2}$  of Townships 22, 23 and 24 North Range 87 West, being withdrawn from the said Rawlins District and to be added to District No. 17 Precinct No. 1 Sinclair.

## DISTRICT NO. 3 - RAWLINS

Beginning at a point on section line between Sections 19 and 20 running on a line in an easterly direction <sup>Tenth</sup> <sup>Cedar</sup> <sup>XX</sup> to the intersection of <sup>Seventh</sup> and Front Streets; thence north on <sup>Seventh</sup> Street to a point in section line between Section 8 and 17; thence west to the northwest corner of Section 17; thence south on section line to point of beginning; all in Township 21 North, Range 87 West.

## DISTRICT NO. 4 - LAMONT

<sup>W</sup> All that territory embraced with the following boundaries shall be known as Election District No. 4; Beginning at the southwest corner of Township 25, North Range 89 West, thence east on a line between Townships 24 and 25 to the North Platte River; thence northwesterly along the North Platte River to the line between Sections 18 and 19; Township 27 North Range 84 West; thence west along the line between Sections 18 and 19; Township 27 North Range 84 West to the line between Ranges 84 and 85, thence north along the line between Ranges 84 and 85 to the north line of Carbon County; thence west along the line between Carbon and Natrona Counties to the line between Carbon and Fremont Counties; thence south along the west line of Carbon County, to the place of beginning.

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DISTRICT NO. 5 - FORT STEELE

All that territory embraced within the following boundaries shall be known as Election District No. 5; beginning at the southeast corner of Township 20, on a line between Ranges 84 and 85; thence north on said line between Ranges 84 and 85, Townships 24 and 25; thence west along said line between Townships 24 and 25 to the line between Ranges 85 and 86; thence south along said line between Ranges 85 and 86 to the line between Townships 19 and 20; thence east along said line to place of beginning except and omitting Sections 6, 7, 19, 18, 30 and 31 Township 21 North, Range 85 West, which are to be withdrawn from said District No. 5 Precinct No. 1 and to be added to District No. 17 Precinct No. 1, Sinclair.

DISTRICT NO. 6 - LEO

All that territory embraced within the following boundaries shall be known as Election District No. 6; Beginning at the southeast corner of Township 25 North, Range 80 West; thence north on Range line between Ranges 79 and 80 to the northeast corner of Township 25 North Range 80 West; thence west on township line between Townships 25 and 26 to the northwest corner of Township 25 North, Range 80 West; thence north along the line between Ranges 80 and 81 to the north line of Carbon County; thence west along the North line of Carbon County to the line between Ranges 84 and 85 West; thence south to the line between Sections 18 and 19, Township 27 North Range 84 West; thence east along said section line to the North Platte River, thence southeasterly along the North Platte River to the line between Townships 24 and 25; thence east along the said township line to the northwest corner of Township 24 North Range 83 West; thence south to the southwest corner of Township 24 North Range 83 West; thence east along the line between Townships 23 and 24 to the southeast corner of Township 24 North Range 82 West; thence north to the northeast corner of Township 24 North Range 82 West; thence east along the line between Townships 24 and 25 North to the place of beginning.

DISTRICT NO. 7 - MEDICINE BOW

All that territory embraced in the following Townships shall be known as Election District No. 7; All of Townships 24, 26, 27 and 28 North Range 80 West; all of Townships 22, 23, 24, 25, 26, 27, and 28 North of Ranges 78 and 79 West; and all of that portion of Townships 22, 23, 24, 25, 26, 27 and 28 North, Range 77 West lying within Carbon County.

DISTRICT NO. 8 - HANNA

All that territory embraced within the following Townships shall be known as Election District No. 8; All of Townships 22 and 23 North, Range 80 West; all of Townships 21, 22 and 23 and 24 North, Range 81 West; all of Townships 21, 22 and 23 North, Ranges 82 and 83 West.

DISTRICT NO. 9 - ELK MOUNTAIN

All that territory embraced within the following Townships shall be known as Election District No. 9; All of Township 18, North, Range 81 West; all of Townships 18, 19, 20 and 21, Range 80 West; All of Townships 20 and 21 North, Ranges 78 and 79 West; all of that portion of Townships 20 and 21 North, Range 77 West, lying within Carbon County.

DISTRICT NO. 10 - MC FADDEN

All that territory embraced within the following Townships shall be known as Election District No. 10; All of Townships 17, 18 and 19 North, Ranges 78 and 79 West; and all that portion of Townships 17, 18 and 19 North, Range 77 West, lying within Carbon County.

DISTRICT NO. 11 - SARATOGA

All of the following described territory shall be included within and known as Election District No. 11: All of Townships 19 and 20 North, Range 81 West; all of Townships 18, 18, 19 and 20 North, and Sections 1 to 6 inclusive of Township 16, North, all in Range 82 West; all of Townships 17, 18, 19 and 20 North, and Sections 1 to 6 inclusive of Township 16 North, all in Range 83 West; all of Township 17 and 18 North, Ranges 84 and 85 West; all of Townships 16 and 17 North, Range 86 West; and all of Township 17 North Range 87 West, and area contained in the drainage areas of Spring Creek and Calf Creek, formerly Spring Creek Precinct 2, District 12.

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DISTRICT NO. 12 - RIVERSIDE

- All that territory embraced within the following boundaries together with that territory within the Town of Riverside, Carbon County, Wyoming, shall be known as Election District No. 12; Beginning at the northeast corner of Section 12, Township 16, North, Range 83 West of the 6th P.M., running thence due West to the south-east corner of Section 1, Township 16 North, Range 84 West; thence north on range line between Ranges 83 and 84 to the Township line between Townships 16 and 17, thence west on township line between Townships 16 and 17 to the range line between Ranges 85 and 86; thence south on range line between Ranges 85 and 86 to the township line between Townships 14 and 15; thence east on township line between Townships 14 and 15 to the range line between Ranges 82 and 83; thence north on the range line between Ranges 82 and 83 to the northeast corner of Section 12, Township 16 North, Range 83 West, of the 6th P.M., the place of beginning, also including all that territory embraced within the corporate limits of the Town of Riverside, Carbon County, Wyoming.

DISTRICT NO. 13 - BENNETT

All that territory embraced within Townships 15, 16 and 17 in Ranges 80 and 81 all of Township 15 North, Range 82 and all of Township 16, North Range 82 West of the 6th P. M., save and except all of Sections 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6 in Township 16 North, Range 82 West of the 6th P.M., shall be known as Election District No. 13.

DISTRICT NO. 14 - ENCAMPMENT

All that territory embraced within Townships 13 and 14, Ranges 80, 81, 82, 83, 84 and 85, and all that portion of Township 12, North Ranges 80, 81, 82, 83 and 84 and 85, which lies in Carbon County, and all of Township 14 North, Range 86, West of the 6th P.M., shall be known as Election District No. 14 save and except that portion which lies within the corporate limits of the Town of Riverside, Carbon County, Wyoming.

DISTRICT NO. 15 - SNAKE RIVER

All that territory embraced within the following boundaries shall be known as Election District No. 15; Beginning at the southeast corner of Township 16 North, Range 86, West; thence west on the township line between Townships 15 and 16 to the range lines between Ranges 86 and 87, thence north on the range line between Ranges 86 and 87 to the township line between Townships 16 and 17; thence west on the township line between Townships 16 and 17 to the range line between Ranges 87 and 88; thence south on the range line between Ranges 87 and 88 to the township line between Townships 15 and 16; thence west on the township line between Townships 15 and 16 to the range line between Ranges 90 and 91; thence north on the range lines between Ranges 90 and 91 to the line between Townships 19 and 20 North; thence west on the township line between Townships 19 and 20 North to the range line between Ranges 93 and 94 West; thence south on the range line between Ranges 93 and 94 West to the Colorado-Wyoming line; thence east along the Colorado-Wyoming line to the range line between Ranges 85 and 86 West; thence north on the range line between Ranges 85 and 86 West to the township line between Townships 13 and 14 North; thence west on the township line between Townships 13 and 14 North to the range line between Ranges 86 and 87 West; thence north on the range line between Ranges 86 and 87 West to the Township line between Townships 14 and 15 North; thence east on the township line between Townships 14 and 15 North to the range line between Ranges 85 and 86 West; thence north on the range line between Ranges 85 and 86 West to the place of beginning.

DISTRICT NO. 16 - WALCOTT

All that territory embraced within Townships 19, 20, 21, 22, 23 and 24 North Range 84 West of the 6th P.M., shall be known as Election District No. 16.

DISTRICT NO. 17 - SINCLAIR

Beginning at the southeast corner of Section 31 Township 21 Range 85, thence north on Section lines to northeast corner, Section 6, Township 21 Range 85, thence west on the north line of Section 6 to the range line between Ranges 85 and 86, thence north along said range line to Township line between Townships 24 and 25, thence west along said township line to the northwest corner of Section 3 Township 24 Range 87, thence south along section lines to the southwest corner of Section 34, Township 22 Range 87, thence east along said township line between Townships 21 and 22 to range line between Ranges 86 and 87, thence south along said range line

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to the township line between townships 21 and 20, thence east on said township line to point of beginning, together with Township 21 North Range 86 West, Townships 22, 23, 24 North Range 86 West, and east half of Townships 22, 23 and 24 North Range 87 West ~~formerly in District No. 2~~; together with Sections, 6, 7, 18, 19, 30 and 31 in Township 21 North Range 85 West ~~formerly in District No. 5~~; shall be known as Election District No. 17.

ELECTION PRECINCTS

PRECINCT NO. 1 DISTRICT NO. 1

All area in District No. 1 lying south of railroad tracks; polling place, Pershing School Gymnasium.

PRECINCT NO. 2 DISTRICT NO. 1

All of District No. 1 lying north of railroad tracks; polling place, City Hall.

PRECINCT NO. 1 DISTRICT NO. 2

Beginning at intersection of Second and Buffalo Streets, thence east on Buffalo Street to a point on section line between Sections 15 and 16; thence north to northeast corner of Section 16; thence west to a point between Section 8 and 17; thence south on Second Street to the point of beginning; polling place, New East Ward School Gymnasium.

PRECINCT NO. 2 DISTRICT NO. 2

Beginning at a point on section line between Sections 8 and 17 running south on Seventh Street to Buffalo street; thence east on Buffalo Street to Second Street; thence north on Second Street to section line between Sections 8 and 17, and all the rest of District No. 2 lying outside the corporate limits of Rawlins. All voters of Election District No. 2 outside of the corporate limits of the City of Rawlins shall vote in precinct No. 2; polling place, Courthouse Community Room. <sup>All residents of Hangers, Happy Hollow and</sup> ~~Rawlins~~ <sup>and</sup> ~~Residential Additions and~~ <sup>Buffalo</sup> <sup>Tenth</sup>

PRECINCT NO. 1 DISTRICT NO. 3

Will include all voters who reside north of Front Street and west of Seventh Street, thence North to the intersection of Spruce Street (Lincoln Highway) and west on the south side of Lincoln Highway to the City Limits, with exception, as shown in Election District No. 2. Polling place will be the show room of McGee Murphy Garage.

PRECINCT NO. 2 DISTRICT NO. 3

Will include all voters who reside west of Seventh Street and North of Lincoln Highway to Date Street, thence west on Date Street to end of street, including all of El Rancho Verde/Additions to Rawlins. Polling place will be in the lobby of the Rawlins (Penland) Motel. <sup>Washington Park</sup>

PRECINCT NO. 3 DISTRICT NO. 3

Will include all voters who reside west of Seventh Street and north of Date Street. Polling place will be the Gymnasium of the Mountain View School.

PRECINCT NO. 1 DISTRICT NO. 4 - LAMONT

Lamont Precinct No. 1 District No. 4, shall embrace all of Townships 25, 26 27 and 28 North, Ranges 88 and 89 W. of the 6th P.M., and Marvin Precinct No. 3, District No. 4 consisting of all of Townships 25 and 26 North, Ranges 85, 86 and 87 W., of the 6th P.M. Polling place, Lamont School, also former District No. 4 Precinct No. 4, Station Eight, consisting of all of Townships 27 and 28 North, Ranges 85, 86 and 87.

PRECINCT NO. 2 DISTRICT NO. 4 - SEMINOE DAM

Seminoe Dam Precinct No. 2 District No. 4 shall consist of all that part of Election District No. 4 described as follows: Beginning at the southwest corner of Township 25 North, Range 84 West, thence east to the North Platte River; thence North along the North Platte River to the Section line between Sections 18 and 19, Township 27 North, Range 84 West; thence west along said section line between sections 18 and 19 to the west line of Range 84 West; thence south along said range line to the southwest corner of Township 25, Range 84, to point of beginning, with the polling place at Seminoe Dam School.

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~~PRECINCT NO. 1 DISTRICT NO. 5 - FORT STEELE~~

Fort Steele Precinct No. 1 shall consist of all that territory embraced within Election District No. 5.

Polling place Paulsen Residence.

Leo Precinct No. 1 shall consist of all that part of Election District No. 6 embraced within Township 25 North, Range 80 West; Townships 25, 26, 27 and 28 North, Range 81 West; Townships 27 and 28 North, Range 82 West, and that territory embraced within Township 26<sup>26</sup> Range 82, and all of Township 26 Range 83, and that part of Township 26, Range 84 West, lying east of the North Platte River, and all that territory embraced in Townships 27 and 28, in Ranges 83 and 84, except that part of Township 27, in Range 84 West, lying west of the North Platte River, together with that territory embraced within former District No. 6, Precinct No. 2, Austin Creek. Polling place - Leo Community Hall.

Medicine Bow Precinct No. 1 shall consist of all that territory embraced within Election District No. 7.

Hanna Precinct No. 1 shall consist of all that territory embraced within Election District No. 8, except Sections 15, 16, 21 and 22 North, Range 81 West of the 6th P.M. Polling Place, Community Hall.

~~PRECINCT NO. 2 DISTRICT NO. 8 - ELMO~~

Elmo Precinct No. 2 shall consist of all that territory embraced within Sections 15 and 16, 21 and 22, in Township 22, North Range 81 West of the 6th P.M., polling place, First Aid Hall.

~~PRECINCT NO. 1 DISTRICT NO. 9 - ELK MOUNTAIN~~

Elk Mountain Precinct No. 1 shall consist of all that territory embraced within Township 18, Range 80 and 81; Township 19, Range 80; Township 20, Ranges 77, 78, 79 and 80; and Township 21, Range 80; and the polling place shall be the TOWN HALL.

~~PRECINCT NO. 2 DISTRICT NO. 9 - KYLE~~

Kyle Precinct No. 2 shall consist of all that territory embraced in Township 21, Ranges 77, 78 and 79. Polling Place, Kyle School.

~~PRECINCT NO. 1 DISTRICT NO. 10 - MC FADDEN~~

McFadden Precinct No. 1 shall consist of all that territory embraced within Township 19, Ranges 77, 78 and 79 in said Election District No. 10. Polling place, Ohio Oil Camp.

~~PRECINCT NO. 1 DISTRICT NO. 11 - SARATOGA~~

Saratoga, Precinct No. 1 shall consist of all that territory embraced within Election District No. 11.

Polling place, Town Hall, also former precinct No. 2 District No. 12 Spring Creek consisting of the territory within the drainage area of Spring Creek and Calf Creek.

~~PRECINCT NO. 2 DISTRICT NO. 12 - SPRING CREEK~~

~~Spring Creek Precinct No. 2 shall consist of all that portion of Election District No. 12, within the drainage area of Spring Creek and Calf Creek. Polling place, Spring Creek Schoolhouse.~~

~~PRECINCT NO. 3 DISTRICT NO. 12 - RIVERSIDE~~

Riverside Precinct No. 3 shall consist of all that territory embraced within Township 15 North, Range 83 West, and also the Town of Riverside in Section 1, Township 14, North Range 84 West, except Sections 5, 6 and 7 in Township 15 North, Range 83 West. Polling place, Town Hall.

~~PRECINCT NO. 1 DISTRICT NO. 13 - BENNETT~~

Bennett Precinct No. 1 shall consist of all that territory embraced in Township 15, Range 82, Township 16, Range 82, excepting Section 1 to 6 inclusive in said township; and all of Township 15 Ranges 80 and 81; polling place to be at Bennett Schoolhouse.

~~PRECINCT NO. 3 DISTRICT NO. 13 - RYAN PARK~~

Ryan Park Precinct No. 3 shall consist of all that territory embraced in Townships 16 and 17, Ranges 80 and 81; the polling place shall be at the Ryan Park Postoffice.

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PRECINCT NO. 1 DISTRICT NO. 14 - COLLINS

Collins Precinct No. 1 shall consist of all that territory embraced within Townships 12, 13 and 14 in Ranges 80, 81, 82 and 83. Polling place, Collins School. *Ralph Platt home.*

PRECINCT NO. 2 DISTRICT NO. 14 - ENCAMPMENT

Encampment Precinct No. 2 shall consist of all that territory embraced within Township 14, North Range 86 West, also all of Townships 12, 13 and 14, Ranges 84 and 85 in said Election District No. 15, save and except that certain territory contained in Riverside Precinct, polling place, Town Hall.

PRECINCT NO. 1 DISTRICT NO. 15 - SAVERIA

Savery Precinct No. 1 shall consist of all that territory embraced within Townships 12, 13 and 15 North, Range 86 West; Townships 12, 13, 14 and 15 and 16 North Range 87 West; Townships 12, 13 and 14 North, Range 88 West; Townships 12 and 13 North, Range 89 West; and Sections 1, 12, 13, 24, 25 and 36 in Township 14 North, Range 89 West. Polling place, upstairs, Savery Store.

PRECINCT NO. 2 DISTRICT NO. 15 - DIXON

Dixon Precinct No. 2 shall consist of all that territory embraced within Townships 12, 13, 14 and 15 North Range 90 West, and also Sections 1, 2, 11, 12, 13, 14, 23, 24, 25, 26, 35 and 36 Townships 14 and 15, North Range 90 West, and all of that territory embraced within Township 15, Ranges 88 and 89 and all of Township 14, Range 89 West, excepting Sections 1, 12, 13, 24, 25 and 36 in Township 14 North, Range 89 West. The above election boundary description includes former Precinct No. 4, District No. 15 Brown's Hill, Polling place, Parish House in Dixon.

PRECINCT NO. 3 DISTRICT NO. 15 - BAGGS

Baggs Precinct No. 3 shall consist of all that part of Election District No. 15 lying in Ranges 91, 92, and 93 West. Polling place, Town Hall.

PRECINCT NO. 1 DISTRICT NO. 16 - WALCOTT

Walcott Precinct No. 1 shall consist of all that territory embraced within Election District No. 16. Polling place, Walcott Schoolhouse.

PRECINCT NO. 1 DISTRICT NO. 17 - SINCLAIR

Sinclair Precinct No. 1 shall consist of all that territory embraced within Election District No. 17. *Former District 5- Ft Steele*  
Polling place, Sinclair Tea Room.

The bid was awarded to Riverstreet Motor Company, being the lowest bidder.

Bids were received from Davies and Son and O'Conner Builders for a concrete retaining wall on west side of courthouse grounds, Davies and Son were awarded the contract for \$850.00.

SCHOOL BOARD ELECTION - DISTRICT NO. 3. The Board then proceeded to act as a canvassing board for the purpose of canvassing the returns of the School Election, held on June 24, 1958, in School District No. 3, in the County of Carbon and State of Wyoming, and found as follows, that John R. Engstrom had received 86 votes, Harold E. Latier had received 85 votes, J. S. Corlew had received 1 vote and that Ralph Moorhead had received 1 vote.

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS the Rawlins Electric Company, a Wyoming corporation, of the City of Rawlins, County of Carbon, State of Wyoming, desires to construct a sub-station for the transmission of electric power, together with an electric transmission line, upon and over the lands hereinafter described and owned by the County of Carbon, State of Wyoming;

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Carbon, State of Wyoming:

That the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Carbon, State of Wyoming, acting by and through its Chairman and the Clerk thereof, be, and they are hereby authorized to make, execute and deliver to the Rawlins Electric Company, a Wyoming corporation, a Warranty Deed to the following described premises, to be used for an electric sub-station site, to-wit:

Beginning at a point, monumented by a 12" iron spike, that bears N0°00' E, a distance of 278.58 ft., and N89°26' W, a distance of 25.00 ft., from the Southeast corner of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec. 18, T. 21 N., R. 87 W. of the 6th P.M., said Southeast corner being an iron rail; thence N89°26' W, a distance of 75.00 ft. to a 12" spike; thence N0°00' E a distance of 100.00 ft. to a 12" iron spike; thence S89°26' E, a distance of 175.00 ft. to a 12" spike; thence S0°00' E, a distance of 100.00 ft. to the point of beginning; said tract of ground being in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec. 18, T. 21 N., R. 87 W. of the 6th P.M. and containing .172 acres, more or less.

That the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Carbon, State of Wyoming, acting by and through its Chairman and the Clerk thereof, be, and they are hereby authorized to make, execute and deliver to the Rawlins Electric Company a perpetual easement for a right-of-way for the construction, operation, maintenance, repair, renewal and re-construction of an electric power, pole and wire line with the necessary appurtenances thereto, upon and along the following described property of the County of Carbon, State of Wyoming, to-wit:

A strip of land 50 feet in width, situated in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec. 18, T. 21 N., R. 87 W. of the 6th P.M. in Carbon County, Wyoming, being 25 ft. in width, measured at right angles, from each side of the following described centerline of the Rawlins Electric Company's power transmission line: Beginning at a point on the South line of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec. 18, T. 21 N., R. 87 W. of the 6th P.M. that is 40.55 ft. West of the Southeast corner of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of said Sec. 18, said Southeast corner being an iron rail; thence N4°42' W, a distance of 279.2 ft. to the South side of the substation site and beginning at the Southwest corner of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec. 18, T. 21 N., R. 87 W. of the 6th P.M.; thence N56°30' E, a distance of 772.54 ft.; thence S90°00' E, a distance of 14.48 ft. to a point on the East line of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of said Sec. 18 that is 432.86 ft.
