In accordance with the provisions of Section 31-401, of the Election Laws of Wyoming, 1958, public notice is hereby given that a municipal primary election will be held in the several polling precincts within the City of Rawlins on Tuesday, August 19, 1958, for the purpose of nominating candidates for the following offices:

ONE MAYOR FOR THE CITY OF RAWLINS FOR A TERM OF TWO YEARS - NON-PARTISAN - ALL CITY WARDS
ONE COUNCILMAN TWO YEAR TERM WARD ONE
ONE COUNCILMAN TWO YEAR TERM WARD TWO
ONE COUNCILMAN TWO YEAR TERM WARD THREE

The said primary election will be held and conducted pursuant to the provisions of the election laws of the State of Wyoming. The above list of offices to be filled was certified to the County Clerk and the Board of County Commissioners by the Secretary of State and the City Clerk of the City of Rawlins on July 28, 1958.

LIQUOR AND MALT BEVERAGE LICENSES as follows were granted by the Board, there being no protest entered.

SHIRLEY RIDGE ROAD: A motion was made by Jackson, seconded by Cheesbrough and carried whereby the following resolution was adopted.

R E S O L U T I O N

WHEREAS, the Utah Mining Corporation has requested the Board of County Commissioners of Carbon County to secure the right of way for the Shirley Ridge Road described as follows:

Commencing at a point located in Section 3, T. 27 N. - R. 80 W. of the 6th P.M.; said point is 3,050 feet south and 1,030 feet west of the north quarter corner of Section 3, in T. 27 N. - R. 80 W.;
thence running in a northeasterly direction for a distance of approximately 15½ miles through Sections 3 and 2 of T. 27 N. - R. 80 W., Sections 35, 36 of T. 28 N. - R. 80 W., Sections 30, 29, 20, 21, 22, 23, 24, 25 of T. 28 N. - R. 79 W., Sections 30, 29, 33, 34, 35 of T. 28 N. - R. 78 W. to a point of ending at the southeast corner of Section 35, T. 28 N. - R. 78 W., right of way to be 50 feet on each side of center line, and,
WHEREAS, The said Board deem the public interest requires that said road be established as a county road.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED; That the Board of County Commissioners of Carbon County, Wyoming, do hereby initiate the procedure for the establishment of said road, and declare their intention to establish said road, by following out the provisions of Article 3, Chapter 48, Wyoming Compiled Statutes, 1945 as amended, not inconsistent therewith.

NOTICE OF LOCATION OF PUBLIC ROAD,,TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

The Board of County Commissioners of Carbon County, Wyoming, have decided to locate a road to be known as the Shirley Ridge Road,

Commencing at a point as described in the above resolution.

The proposed location and width of right of way required are set forth in detail on a map on file with the County Clerk and may be examined at his office.

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Any land owner or interested party desiring to raise any question with respect to the necessity of the taking of the land for road purposes shall do so by filing, within thirty days after the last publication of this notice, a petition in the District Court of the county in which the land is located. If no petition to raise the question of necessity is filed within the said thirty day period, the necessity shall be presumed and the question cannot later be raised,

All other objections thereto or claims for damages by reason thereof must be filed in writing with the County Clerk of said county before noon on the 3rd day of September A.D. 1958, or such road will be established without reference to such objections or claims for damages.

APPROPRIATION RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, on the 9th day of June, 1958 R. G. Engstrom County Clerk the budget making authority, prepared and submitted to the Board a county budget for the 1958-1959 fiscal year ending June 30, 1959;

WHEREAS, such a budget was duly entered at large upon the records of this Board and a copy thereof was made available for public inspection at the office of the County Clerk; and

WHEREAS, notice of a public hearing on such budget, together with the summary of said budget, was published in the Rawlins Daily Times a legal newspaper published and of general circulation in the county on the 15th day of July, 1958 and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held on such budget at the time and place specified in said notice, at which time all interested parties were given an opportunity to be heard; and

WHEREAS, following such public hearing certain alterations and revisions were made in such proposed budget, all of which more fully appear in the minutes of this Board,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners that the county budget, as so revised and altered, be adopted as the official county budget for the 1958-1959 fiscal year ending June 30, 1959.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the following appropriations be made for the 1958-1959 fiscal year ending June 30, 1959, and that the expenditures of each officer, department or spending agency be limited to the amount herein appropriated.
