SEMINOE ROAD - CARBON COUNTY:

A motion was made, seconded and carried whereby the following Resolution was unanimously adopted.

R E S O L U T I O N

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of the County of CARBON is desirous of taking advantage of the provisions of Chapter 99, and/or Chapter 118, Session Laws of Wyoming, 1951, by cooperating with the State Highway Commission of Wyoming in the improvement of a county road, the location and extent of which is as follows:

September 3, 1958

SEMINOE DAM ROAD:

(A) New construction:

From the end of SC-CFM 3784 in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 12, T. 22 N., R. 86 W., thence northeasterly approximately 12 miles.

(B) Repairing SC-CFM 3784:

From the end of SC-CFM 3419 in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 24, T. 22 N., R. 86 W., Thence northeasterly for approximately 3.8 miles to a point in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 12, T. 22 N., R. 86 W.

(A) Grading, Draining, base course surfacing, 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " road mixed mat, sand gravel seal, traffic signs and miscellaneous work.


(B) Repair present sand seal, place rip-rap where needed, traffic signs and miscellaneous work.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by said Board:

THAT, the Board enter into a written agreement with said Commission covering said improvement in accordance with a contract therefor, now submitted to said Board by said Commission, which agreement is hereby approved and ordered filed in the office of the County Clerk of said county; that the chairman of said Board and the County Clerk of said county be, and they are hereby authorized and directed to execute said contract on behalf of said Board.

I, the undersigned, County Clerk of Carbon, County, State of Wyoming, do hereby certify that at a legal meeting of the Board of County Commissioners at which a quorum was present, said Board adopted a resolution of which the foregoing is a full, true and complete copy.

ABANDONMENT OF OLD RAWLINS - SARATOGA ROAD AND ROBBER'S GULCH-RAWLINS ROAD.

A motion was duly made, seconded and unanimously carried whereby the following resolution was adopted.

R E S O L U T I O N

WHEREAS, certain sections of early established County roads have become obsolete from the standpoint of modern requirements and general utility as public thoroughfares, and

THEREFORE, the Board of County Commissioners now deems it in the public interest to vacate such roads,

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY the Board of County Commissioners of Carbon County in regular meeting assembled, that the sections of County roads identified and described herein below, be declared vacated and abandoned, the right of way therefore being hereby released unto the owners of the lands they traverse; that the section of road known and recorded as Robber's Gulch - Rawlins Road as established by a former Board of County Commissioners on December 29, 1923 and recorded in Book 7, Page 138 of Commissioners Proceedings, beginning at the intersection of said road with the north line of Section 5, T. 17 N., R. 90 W. of the 6th P.M., thence southwesterly across Sections 5, 4, 8, 17, 18 and 19 of said Township and Range; thence continuing southwesterly across Sections 24, 25 and 36, T. 17 N., Range 91 W.; Thence southwesterly across Sections 2, 11, 10, 15, 16, 21 and 28 T. 16 N. R. 91 W., ending at the intersections of said road with the west line of said Sec. 28, the length of said section to be abandoned being 11.8 miles more or less. Also that section of road known and recorded as the old Rawlins Saratoga Road as platted on Page 10 of the County Road Book and considered by a former Board of County Commissioners, ~~as recorded~~ as recorded in Book 1, Page 362 of Commissioners Proceedings; beginning at the intersection of said road with the North line of Section 2, T. 20 N. R. 87 W. 6th P.M.; thence southeasterly across Sections 2, 11, 14, 21, 26, 25 and 36 T. 20 N. R. 87 W.; thence southeasterly across Sections 6, 5, 8, 9, 10, 15, 22, 23 and 25 T. 19 N. R. 85 W. ending at the intersection of said road with the east line of said Section 25, the length of said section to be abandoned being 13.5 miles more or less.

All objections and claims for damages must be filed in writing with the County Clerk of said County before noon on October 8, 1958 or such road will be abandoned without reference to such objections or claims for damages.

SHIRLEY RIDGE ROAD: A motion was made, seconded and carried whereby the following resolution was adopted.

R E S O L U T I O N

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Carbon County, Wyoming did on July 28, 1958 adopt a resolution declaring intent to establish road to be known as Shirley Ridge Road, described in notice of public road on record in Office of County Clerk - Commissioner Record 11 on Page 102, and

WHEREAS, all land owners affected by said proposed road have been notified by registered mail, and


WHEREAS, the date of filing objections or claims for damages expired at noon September 3, 1958, and

WHEREAS, a protest and claim for damages was filed at 11:00 A. M., on September 3, 1958 with the County Clerk by the Tidewater Oil Company in which damages were claimed if the proposed road would cross the protestant's Mining Claims in Section 32, 33, 34, Township 28 N. Range 78, 6th P.M., and


THEREFORE, the Board of Commissioners decided to terminate the road at a point North 70°45' West, 600 feet from SE corner of Section 29, Township 28, Range 78 W., the protestant having agreed that no claim for damages or objection would be made if the road terminated at the point described above.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved; That the road described in Commissioner's Record 11 on Page 102 and shown in detail on map on file in the Office of the County Clerk of said County, be and is hereby declared established as described above, with a new point of termination.

There being no further business the meeting was adjourned.
