WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council of the City of Rawlins, Carbon County, Wyoming, at a regular meeting thereof on June 8th, 1959, pursuant to the terms of 29-206 and 29-302 of the Wyoming Compiled Statutes of 1945 extended the City Limits of said City to include Painter Addition thereto, and accepted and confirmed the dedication to public use of the streets and driveways laid out therein, and

WHEREAS, said Painter Addition is platted over land adjacent to the City of Rawlins, Carbon County, Wyoming, and therefore pursuant to Section 29-1102 requires joint approval of the Board of County Commissioners and the legislative body of said City of Rawlins.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Carbon, State of Wyoming, pursuant to the terms of Section 29-1102 of the Compiled Statutes of 1945 do hereby approve the plat of Painter Addition to the City of Rawlins, Carbon County, Wyoming, submitted by Charles A. RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF CARBON, STATE OF WYOMING, APPROVING
KASPAR & HAGINS ADDITION TO THE CITY OF RAWLINS:

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council of the City of Rawlins, County of Carbon, State of Wyoming, at a regular meeting thereof on June 8, 1959, pursuant to the terms of section 29-206 and section 29-302 of the Wyoming Compiled Statutes of 1945, extended the City Limits of said City to include the Kaspar & Hagins Addition thereto, and accepted and confirmed the dedication to public use the streets laid out therein, and

WHEREAS, said Kaspar & Hagins Addition is platted over land adjacent and contiguous to the City of Rawlins, Carbon County, Wyoming, and whereas Section 29-1102 of the Wyoming Compiled Statutes of 1945 requires joint approval of the Board of County Commissioners and the legislative body of the said City of Rawlins.
