COMMISSIONERS PROCEEDINGS
TAX LEVY MEETING

1 - 1960

The Board of Commissioners met August 3rd, 1959 at 10:00A.M., Salisbury and Orton present, Olsen absent, together with the County Assessor R. A. Hakala, for the purpose of fixing the Tax Levies for and within Carbon County for the year 1959-60 in compliance with Chapter 32-512, Wyoming Statutes of 1945.

Having received from the State Board of Equalization notice that the assessed valuation of Carbon County for the year 1959-60 has been found to be \$44,113,999, the County Assessor advised the Board of the assessed valuation of each of the various municipalities and school districts with the County, and the Board proceeded to fix the levies upon the assessed property of Carbon County for the year 1959-60 as follows:

The City of Rawlins requested a levy sufficient to raise the sum of \$7450.43 to cover an item described as "Kelly Judgment", but upon the advise of the County Attorney, the Board was unable to comply with this request, and no levy was made in excess of the statutory limitation.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
