REGULAR MEETING

The Board of Commissioners met at 10:00 A.M., Jackson, Salisbury and Olsen present, Jackson, Chairman. and Jan. 5, 1959  
The minutes of meetings held December 2nd and 3rd were read and approved.

MONTHLY REPORTS of County Officers were audited and approved.

POLL TAX: A motion was made by Salisbury and seconded by Olsen and carried whereby the County Assessor was authorized to proceed with the collection of Poll Tax for the year 1959 in compliance with Section 32-406 WCS 1945.

APPOINTMENTS as follows were made by the Board.

James E. Cashman, M.D., was re-appointed as County Health Officer for a two year term, commencing January 5, 1959.
