ELECTION PROCLAMATION

Notice is hereby given that in compliance with Section 22-17 Wyoming Statutes 1957, a General Election will be held in the several voting precincts of the County of Carbon, State of Wyoming, on Tuesday November 8th, 1960, at which the following officers will be chosen, to-wit:

One President of the United States.

One Vice-President of the United States.

Three Presidential Electors.

One United States Senator.

One Representative in Congress.

Three Representatives in the State Legislature.

One County Commissioner.

One Justice of the Peace for a two year term in Justice Precinct No. 1, No. 3 and No. 8.

One Non-Partisan Justice of the Supreme Court - Eight Year Term.

One Justice of the Supreme Court - Four Year Term, as authorized by Constitutional Amendment of 1958.

One Non-Partisan Superintendent of Schools - County Two Year Term.

Proposed Constitutional Amendments No. 1, 2 & 3.

One Mayor for the City of Rawlins - Non Partisan.

One Councilman for Ward One, City of Rawlins - Non-Partisan.

One Councilman for Ward Two, City of Rawlins - Non-Partisan.

One Councilman for Ward Three, City of Rawlins - Non-Partisan.
