This proposed amendment to the Constitution of the State of Wyoming allows cities, towns, villages, or subdivisions thereof to create indebtedness not to exceed four per cent (4%) of the assessed value of the taxable property within such city, town, village, or subdivision thereof, whereas the present provisions of the Constitution restrict the creation of indebtedness to two per cent (2%) of the assessed value of taxable property.

PROPOSED CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT NO. 3

Proposal to amend Section 6, Article XV, of the Constitution of the State of Wyoming to read and provide as follows:

"Article XV, Section 6. No incorporated city or town shall levy a tax to exceed twelve (12) mills on the dollar in any on year, except for the payment of its public debt and the interest thereon."

This proposed amendment to the Constitution of the State of Wyoming, allows cities and towns to increase their tax levies to twelve (12) mills instead of the present maximum of eight (8) mills.



R E S O L U T I O N

WHEREAS, the tax levied under authority of Chapter 158, Session Laws of Wyoming 1959 as a 5 Mill High School Tax has been declared unconstitutional and invalid by the District Court of Sweetwater County, Wyoming, and the decision of such District Court has been affirmed by the Supreme Court of Wyoming by decision, dated October 11, 1960,

NOW BE IT, THEREFORE, RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Carbon County, Wyoming, that the taxes collected by the Treasurer of Carbon County represented by or resulting from the special 5 mill county high school levy hereinabove referred to and described be refunded to the respective taxpayers entitled thereto and that said county authority shall make said refund to said taxpayers entitled thereto forthwith and consistent with proper accounting procedure.

RETTSTATT ADDITION, AMENDED PLAT. The Board approved an amended plat of Rettstatt Addition to the City of Rawlins Wyoming, prepared under direction and authority of County Clerk R. G. Engstrom, in compliance with Section 34-123 Wyoming Statutes-1957.

R E S O L U T I O N

WHEREAS, the Sinclair Oil and Gas Company, a corporation, filed a suit in Sweetwater County, Wyoming, being Civil Action No. 6195 in the District Court of said Sweetwater County, alleging that the 5 mill Special County High School tax authorized by Chapter 158 of the Session Laws of Wyoming, 1959, was unconstitutional and at the trial of said matter the District Court having held for the plaintiff therein finding that the said tax was in fact unconstitutional and,

WHEREAS, said decision of the Sweetwater County District Court having been appealed to the Supreme Court of the State of Wyoming and said Supreme Court having affirmed the decision of the Sweetwater County District Court and having found that as a matter of fact and law that the special 5 mill tax for high schools hereinabove described was unconstitutional and,

WHEREAS, the Platte Pipeline Company and others as plaintiffs instituted a suit in the United States District Court for the District of Wyoming naming various County Treasurers throughout the State of Wyoming including Joel Hays, Treasurer of Carbon County, as defendants therein alleging that the taxes hereinabove referred to were unconstitutional and praying among other relief for the refund of said taxes paid to the various counties by the said plaintiffs as a result of the special 5 mill high school levy and, the Federal District Court having entered its judgment in said cause finding generally for the plaintiffs and against the defendants, and their agents, etc., and said Court having ordered the defendants to make full refund of the moneys so collected from the plaintiffs therein specified and all other persons similarly situated, and

WHEREAS, the Sinclair Oil and Gas Company filed in the District Court of Carbon County, Wyoming, on May 10, 1960, Civil Case No. 7418, its complaint against Joel Hays, Treasurer of Carbon County, Wyoming, alleging that the said tax hereinabove referred to was unconstitutional and praying for the refund to the plaintiff from the defendant in the sum of \$20,878.76, and

WHEREAS, no disposition has been made by the Court of said case, but that it appears that the law regarding the validity of said assessment has been fully and adequately set forth by both the Supreme Court of the State of Wyoming and the Federal District Court for the District of Wyoming and that nothing would be accomplished by further proceedings in Civil No. 7418 and plaintiff having agreed to dismiss said cause of action against the defendant upon payment to it of the sum therein specified and prayed for and it appearing that on the strength and authority of the District Court judgment hereinabove cited that the Carbon County authorities are bound by law to refund the taxes collected as a result of the 5 mill special county high school tax levied as provided in Chapter 158 of the Session Laws of Wyoming, 1959,

BE IT, THEREFORE, RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Carbon County, Wyoming, that the taxes collected by the Treasurer of Carbon County represented by or resulting from the special 5 mill county high school levy hereinabove referred to and described be refunded to the respective taxpayers entitled thereto and that said county authority shall make said refund to said taxpayers entitled thereto forthwith and consistent with proper accounting procedure.
