COMMISSIONERS PROCEEDINGS
SPECIAL MEETING

The Board met in special session at 7:00 P.M., all members present, George R. Salisbury, Jr. Chairman, to consider a special election for the issuing of bonds for a public auditorium, civic center and community building.

A motion was made, seconded and carried whereby the following proclamation and notice of election was adopted:

PROCLAMATION AND NOTICE OF ELECTION

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a special election of the qualified electors of Carbon County, Wyoming, will be held in said county on Tuesday, the 8th day of August, 1961, in the following polling places, to-wit:

for the purpose of voting on the following proposal, to-wit:

"Shall the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Carbon, State of Wyoming, be authorized to issue registered coupon bonds of the county to an amount of Eighty-Four Thousand Dollars (\$84,000.00) and bearing interest at a rate not exceeding six per cent (6%) per annum for the purpose of providing funds to develop and to acquire lands and other property for a public auditorium, civic center and community building?"

The official ballot, after the statement of the proposal, shall contain the words "BONDS, YES" and "BONDS, NO".

In each polling place, the electors shall prepare his or her ballot by marking an "X" to express his or her vote upon the question submitted.

The polls at each polling place shall be opened at 9 o'clock, A. M. on said date and shall remain open until and shall be closed at 7 o'clock P. M. of said day.

Every citizen of the United States of the age of 21 years and upwards who has resided in the state one year and in the municipality 60 days next preceding such election and who has complied with the registration laws in the event that prior registration is required at such election, shall be entitled to vote thereat. If such elector is not the owner of, or the spouse of the owner of, real or personal property assessed on the assessment roll of Carbon County, he shall be furnished by the officers conducting such election a ballot printed on white paper, and the ballots of all such persons shall be deposited in ballot box "A". If such elector is the owner of, or the spouse of the owner of, real or personal property assessed on the assessment roll of said Carbon County, he shall be furnished by such officers a ballot printed on colored paper and the ballots of all such persons shall be deposited in ballot box "B". Before any person shall be permitted to vote a ballot printed on colored paper he shall be required to make before the officers of election an affidavit showing that he is the owner of, or the spouse of the owner of, real or personal property assessed on the assessment rolls in the state or municipality as the case may be.
