COMMUNITY BUILDING BONDS. A motion was made by Sullins, seconded by Patton and carried whereby the following resolution was adopted.

R E S O L U T I O N

WHEREAS, the qualified electors of Carbon County, Wyoming, voted at a special election in said County on August 8, 1961, on the following proposal, to-wit:

"Shall the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Carbon, State of Wyoming, be authorized to issue registered coupon bonds of the County to an amount of Eighty-four Thousand Dollars (\$84,000.00) and bearing interest at a rate not exceeding six per cent (6%) per annum for the purpose of providing funds to develop and to acquire lands and other property for a public auditorium, civic center and community building?", and;

WHEREAS, the certificate of the Board of Canvassers has heretofore been filed with R. G. Engstrom, the duly elected, qualified and acting County Clerk and Ex-officio Register of Deeds, Carbon County, Wyoming, showing that a majority of said electors, both property owners and non-property owners, voted affirmatively and said proposal has carried, and;

WHEREAS, Notice of Intention to Issue and sell the registered coupon bonds of Carbon County, Wyoming, in amount of Eighty-four Thousand Dollars (\$84,000.00), should be published pursuant to law.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the County Clerk of the County of Carbon, be, and he hereby is, authorized and directed to cause to be published pursuant to law, Notice of Intention to Issue and Notice of Sale of said bonds in amount of Eighty-four Thousand Dollars (\$84,000.00), in the denomination of \$1,000.00 each divided into series so that said bonds will be redeemed in substantially equal amounts within a period of five years (5), said bonds to bear interest at a rate not exceeding six per cent (6%) per annum payable semi-annually.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Tallmadge & Tallmadge, Attorneys at Law, 517 American National Bank Building, Denver, Colorado, be, and they are hereby, retained to render approving opinion on the legality of said \$84,000.00 bond issue at a fee of Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$250.00).

SECTION 1-B ENCAMPMENT-FRENCH-HOLMES ROAD & SPUR TO ROUSE BRIDGE ACROSS THE NORTH PLATTE RIVER.

On August 12, 19 and 26, 1961, a Notice of Location of the above proposed road was published in the Daily Times, official newspaper of Carbon County, Wyoming.

A motion was made by Sullins, seconded by Patton and carried whereby the location of the above proposed road is hereby rescinded account of errors in description, and a corrected Notice of Location of Public Road was authorized for publication as follows:

NOTICE OF LOCATION OF PUBLIC ROAD

TO ALL WHOM IT MAY CONCERN: The Board of County Commissioners of Carbon County, Wyoming, have decided to locate a road to be known as the SECTION 1 - B ENCAMPMENT - FRENCH - HOLMES ROAD AND SPUR TO ROUSE BRIDGE ACROSS THE NORTH PLATTE RIVER.

September 6, 1961.

Beginning at a point on the South Line of Section 24, Twp. 15 N. Range 83 W., 336' West of the S. E. Corner thereof, thence Northeasterly across Sections 24 and 19; thence Southeasterly across Sections 19, 20, 21, 28, 27, 24, and 35 Twp. 15 N. Range 82 West of the 6th P. M., a distance of 4.95 miles, more or less; thence Northeasterly across Sections 35 and 36, Twp. 15 N. Range 82 West 6th P. M.; a distance of 0.45 of a mile, more or less, to connection with U. S. Forest Service Road No. 284, extending to Fox Park and Holmes. The exact route of the above proposed road is shown on a map, prepared by the County Surveyor, on file in the office of the County Clerk in Rawlins, Wyoming. 2000

Proposed Section to be constructed is 6.60 miles in length; more or less.

Right of way to be 80 ft. wide lying Northwesterly and adjacent to the present fence described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the South line of aforesaid Section 24, 290 ft. West of the S. E. Corner thereof; thence N.  $35^{\circ}00'$  E., a distance of 3915 ft; thence on a curve right of  $5^{\circ}$ , a distance of 690 ft., thence N.  $69^{\circ}30'$  E., a distance of 579 ft; thence N.  $84^{\circ}30'$  E., a distance of 455 ft; thence the right of way converges to the overall width of the present bridge, or as such bridge may be widened in the future, over Beaver Creek; through a distance of 100 ft., thence N.  $83^{\circ}00'$  E., a distance of 30 ft., and the overall width of said present or future bridge, thence from the N.E. Corner of said bridge N.  $81^{\circ}00'$  E., a distance of 700 ft. along the present fence, the right of way lies southerly of and adjacent thereto and diverges in width from the overall width of present or future bridge to 60 ft. at a distance of 500 ft. east of said bridge, thence continues 60 ft. in width southerly of and adjacent to the present fence for a distance of 2015 ft. to the P. C. of a  $10^{\circ}$  curve right; thence the right of way diverges in width from 60 ft. to 80 ft. through said curve, a distance of 700 ft., and continues 80 ft. in width, being  $40^{\circ}$  on each side of a center line, all as shown on plats on file in the office of the County Clerk.

#### SPUR TO ROUSE BRIDGE:

Beginning at a point on the Encampment - French - Holmes Road, 1303' N.  $73^{\circ}00'$  E. from the W $\frac{1}{4}$  Corner Section 20 T. 15 N. Range 83 W., thence Northeasterly on a  $20^{\circ}$  curve left to point of tangency with the center line of Rouse Bridge produced Southwesterly; thence Northeasterly on said center line to the Northerly end of said Bridge and junction with the terminus of Lower Brush Creek Road at a point 1934.7' N.  $55^{\circ}21'$  E., from aforesaid W $\frac{1}{4}$  Corner Section 20, a distance of 1/8 mile; more or less.

Right of way to be 60 ft. in width to a point 50 ft. South of the South end of said bridge, thence converging to the overall width of the bridge at the South Abutment thereof; thence overall width of the bridge to junction with Lower Brush Creek Road as shown on plats on file with the County Clerk.

All objections thereto or claims for damages by reason thereof must be filed in writing with the County Clerk of said County before noon on the 9th day of October, 1961, or such road will be established without reference to such objections or claims for damages.
