In compliance with Section 9-535, Wyoming Laws 1957, a Notice of Hearing on the proposed transfer of funds from the Cash Reserve Fund was advertised on March 16, 1961, as follows:

A motion was made by Patton and carried whereby the following resolution was adopted, to-wit:

**RESOLUTION**

WHEREAS, the above budgets have become depleted due to unanticipated costs.

IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, THAT the County Budget Officer and County Treasurer be authorized to transfer the above mentioned funds.

F. B. Cronberg was appointed Justice of the Peace for Justice/No. 4, Medicine Bow for the term beginning April 4, 1961, expiring January 7, 1963, to fill the unexpired term of A. F. Gates. The bond of \$1000.00 was approved by the Commissioners.

Thereupon the Board adjourned until the following day.
