## CITY OF RAWLINS-WATER BOND ELECTION:

A special meeting of the Board of County Commissioners of Carbon County, Wyoming, was held at the hour of 4:30 o'clock p.m., pursuant to due notice and call, at the County Court House at Rawlins, Wyoming, on Thursday, the 11th day of January, 1962.

The Chairman called the meeting to order and upon roll call the following were found to be present:

constituting all the members of the Board.

The following proceedings, among others, were had and taken:

Thereupon, Commissioner Sullins introduced and moved the adoption of the following resolution, which was thereupon read in full and is as follows:

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the City Clerk of the City of Rawlins, in the County of Carbon and State of Wyoming, has transmitted a certified copy of an ordinance adopted and approved by the City Council of the City of Rawlins, on the 8th day of January, 1962, to the County Clerk for the Board of County Commissioners of Carbon County; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has determined, and does hereby determine, that it is necessary and for the best interest of the City of Rawlins, and the county, and its inhabitants, to provide for the authorization and issuance of said bonds in the aggregate principal amount of \$425,000.00, or so much thereof as may be necessary, to provide funds for supplying water to such City by extending and maintaining the municipal waterworks.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF CARBON COUNTY, STATE OF WYOMING:

Section 1. That all action heretofore taken by the City Council of the City of Rawlins, the officers thereof,

and the officers of Carbon County, directed toward submitting the question of issuing the negotiable, coupon general obligation bonds of said City in the aggregate principal amount of \$425,000.00, or so much thereof as may be necessary for the purpose of supplying water to such City by extending and maintaining the municipal waterworks, be, and the same hereby is, ratified; approved and confirmed, including, without limiting the generality of the foregoing, the adoption by said City Council of said ordinance on the 8th day of January, 1962, and all action taken pursuant thereto.

Section 2. That the County Clerk shall give notice of the action hereby taken by transmitting to the Clerk of said City of Rawlins, Wyoming, for said City Council, a certified copy of this resolution.

Section 3. That the officers of the County of Carbon, be, and they hereby are, authorized and directed to take all action necessary or appropriate to effectuate the provisions of this resolution and Ordinance No. 287, Series 1962, passed and adopted on the 8th day of January, 1962, by the City Council of the City of Rawlins, Wyoming.

Section 4. That all resolutions or parts thereof in conflict with this resolution are hereby repealed.

Section 5. That if any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this resolution shall for any reason be held to be invalid or unenforceable, the invalidity or unenforceability of such section, paragraph, clause or provision shall not affect any of the remaining provisions of this resolution.

Section 6. That by reason of the fact that said City is not properly or adequately supplied with water facilities, it is hereby declared that an emergency exists, that this resolution is necessary to the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and that it shall be in full force and effect immediately after its adoption and approval.

Section 7. That this resolution shall be entered on record in the minute book of the Board of County Commissioners, and the County Clerk is authorized and directed to carry out the provisions thereof.
