


MINUTES OF MEETING, May 27, 1963

The Board of County Commissioners of Carbon County, Wyoming met as a Board of Equalization in Room 104 of the Carbon County Courthouse at the hour of 10:00 A.M., on the 27th day of May, 1963, as provided by Title 39 Chapter 4, Wyoming Statutes, 1957. Present at the meeting: Mr. George Salisbury, Chairman, Mr. John Orton and Mr. John Niland. Mr. R. A. Hakala, Carbon County Assessor, acted as Clerk of the Board.

Routine check of the Carbon County Assessment Roll was conducted by the Board. The Board was apprised of the return for 1963 of the Union Pacific Railroad Company and after considering the facts at hand, concurred with the Assessor to set the Union Pacific valuations at the same level as they were in 1962. The clerk was instructed to notify the taxpayer that the valuations would be increased from \$752,842 to \$814,657. The Board adjourned at 4:00 P.M. to meet again on the 10th day of June, 1963.




