NOTICE OF LOCATION OF PUBLIC ROAD

TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

The Board of County Commissioners of Carbon County, Wyoming, have decided to locate a road to be known as LEO COUNTY ROAD, No. 102.

Commencing at a point of intersection with Wyo. Highway 487 in section 4, T.26N., R.80W., and extending westerly through the following described lands: sections 4, 5, 7, & 8 T.26N., R.80W.; sections 4, 5, 6, 9, 10, 11, & 12 T.26N., R.81 W.; sections 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, & 6 T.26N., R.82W.; sections 1, 2, 8, 9, 10, 11 T.26N., R.83W., terminating at a point of intersection with the Hanna to Leo county road. The right of way shall be one hundred (100) feet in width, being fifty (50) feet right and fifty (50) feet left of the centerline. Approximate length of road is 21.14 miles.

The proposed location and width of right of way required are set forth in detail on a map on file with the County Clerk and may be examined at his office.

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Any land owner or interested party desiring to raise any question with respect to the necessity of the taking of the land for road purposes shall do so by filing, within thirty days after the last publication of this notice, a petition in the District Court of the county in which the land is located. If no petition to raise the question of necessity is filed within the said thirty day period, the necessity shall be presumed and the question cannot later be raised.

All other objections thereto or claims for damages by reason thereof must be filed in writing with the County Clerk of said county before noon on the 7th day of August, A. D., 1963, or such road will be established without reference to such objections or claims for damages.

TRANSFER OF FUNDS FROM CASH RESERVE

In compliance with Section 20-811 of the Municipal Budget Act. W.C.S. 1945, as amended in the Sessions Laws of 1947, A Notice of Hearing on the proposed transfer of funds from the Cash Reserve Fund was advertised June 10, 1963 as follows: Road & Bridge Department \$5000.00, Court House & Jail \$500.00, Water Commissioner \$1700.00.

A motion was made by Niland and carried whereby the following resolution was adopted, to-wit:

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the above budgets have become depleted due to unanticipated costs.

IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the County Budget Officer and County Treasurer be authorized to transfer the above mentioned funds.

COMMUNITY BUILDING: An agreement was entered into between Dr. C. W. Jeffrey and the County Commissioners to enlarge the basement of the new Community building for storage purposes and was placed on file in the office of the County Clerk.

DEPUTY CLERK OF COURT: The Commissioners confirmed the appointment of Mary C. Engstrom as Deputy Clerk of Court.
