SPECIAL MEETING.

The Board met at 2:00 P. M. all members present, George R. Salisbury Jr., Chairman.

A motion was made by Orton, seconded by Niland and carried whereby the following resolution was adopted.

R E S O L U T I O N

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Carbon, is desirous of taking advantage of the provisions of Section 24-38, W.S. 1957, and/or Chapter 118, Session Laws of Wyoming, 1951, by cooperating with the State Highway Commission of Wyoming in the improvement of a county road, the location and extent of which is as follows:

Saratoga - Ryan Park Road

Commencing at a point just East of the Saratoga bridge in SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 12 T17N, R84W, thence running in a Southeasterly direction through Section 12, T17N R84 W and Section 18, T17N, R83W along an existing county road to a point on this road in NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 18, T17N, R83W.

A distance of approximately 1.14 miles.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by said Board:

THAT the Board enter into a written agreement with said Commission covering said improvement in accordance with a contract therefor, now submitted to said Board by said Commission, which agreement is hereby approved and ordered filed in the office of the County Clerk of said county; that the chairman of said Board and the County Clerk of said county be, and they are hereby authorized and directed to execute said contract on behalf of said Board.

CONTINENTAL PIPELINE COMPANY: PIPE LINE ORDER.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND ADJUDGED by the Board of County Commissioners of said county that permission be granted to the Continental Pipe Line Company, its successors and assigns to use as much of the roadway as described in permit on file in the office of County Clerk, across county roads for the laying of a pipe line. Said line to be constructed in accordance with all the rules of the County Commissioners and under the supervision of the County Engineer, upon the condition that should any future modifications of any of the above roads require relocation or change in depth of said pipe lines, the expense thereof will be borne by Continental Pipe Line Co. The above order does not apply to any State Highway.

The Board reviewed the tentative budget requests presented for the County General, Library, Hospital, General Welfare, General Welfare Health, Fair, Museum and bond retirement and interest. Several changes were made in the requests and the Board adjourned until 8:00 o'clock P. M. at which time a Public Hearing of the Budget Requests will be held.

The Board met at 8:00 P.M., at which time all interested persons were heard relative to the budget requests. A motion was made by Orton, seconded by Niland and carried whereby the following resolution was adopted.

APPROPRIATION RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, on the 10th day of June, 1963, R. G. Engstrom, County Clerk, the budget making authority, prepared and submitted to the Board a county budget for the 1963-1964 fiscal year ending June 30, 1964,

WHEREAS, such a budget was duly entered at large upon the records of this Board and a copy thereof was made available for public inspection at the office of the County Clerk; and

WHEREAS, notice of a public hearing on such budget, together with the summary of said budget, was published in the Rawlins Daily Times, a legal newspaper published and of general circulation in the county on the 11th day of July, 1963, and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held on such budget at the time and place specified in said notice, at which time all interested parties were given an opportunity to be heard; and

WHEREAS, following such public hearing certain alterations and revisions were made in such proposed budget, all of which more fully appear in the minutes of this Board.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners that the county budget, as so revised and altered, be adopted as the official county budget for the 1963-1964 fiscal year ending June 30, 1964.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the following appropriations be made for the 1963-1964 fiscal year ending June 30, 1964, and that the expenditures of each officer, department or spending agency be limited to the amount herein appropriated.
