COMMISSIONERS' PROCEEDINGS
SPECIAL MEETING.

The Board met at 2:00 P.M. all members present, George R. Salisbury, Jr., Chairman.

A motion was made by Orton, seconded by Niland and carried whereby the following resolution was adopted.

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Carbon, is desirous of taking advantage of the provisions of Chapter 99, and/or Chapter 118, Session Laws of Wyoming, 1951, by cooperating with the State Highway Commission of Wyoming in the improvement of a county road, the location and extent of which is as follows:

Seminoe Dam Road

Locally known as the Seminoe Dam Road. Beginning at the North Sinclair City Limits (Sect. 16, T 21 N, R 86 W) and going in a N.N.E. direction to the boundary of U.S. Gov't. Land (Sect. 30, T 25 N., R 84 W).

1. Grade, drain, gravel and road mix surfacing on approximately 2½ miles.
2. Grade, drain and base course surfacing on approximately 6 miles.
3. Place a sand-gravel seal coat on approximately 24 miles of road.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by said Board:

THAT the Board enter into a written agreement with said Commission covering said improvement in accordance with a contract therefor, now submitted to said Board by said Commission, which agreement is hereby approved and ordered filed in the office of the County Clerk of said county; that the chairman of said Board and the County Clerk of said county, be, and they are hereby authorized and directed to execute said contract on behalf of said Board.

I, the undersigned, County Clerk of Carbon County, State of Wyoming, do hereby certify that at a legal meeting of the Board of County Commissioners at which a quorum was present, said Board adopted a resolution of which the foregoing is a full, true and complete copy.

WHEREAS, notice of a public hearing on such budget, together with the summary of said budget, was published in the Rawlins Daily Times, a legal newspaper published and of general circulation in the county on the 16th day of July, 1964, and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held on such budget at the time and place specified in said notice, at which time all interested parties were given an opportunity to be heard; and

WHEREAS, following such public hearing certain alterations and revisions were made in such proposed budget, all of which more fully appear in the minutes of this Board.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners that the county budget, as so revised and altered, be adopted as the official county budget for the 1964-1965 fiscal year ending June 30, 1965.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the following appropriations be made for the 1964-1965 fiscal year ending June 30, 1964, and that the expenditures of each officer, department of spending agency be limited to the amount herein appropriated.
