MOUNTAIN STATES T & T CO. APPLICATION FOR BURIED CABLE RIGHT OF WAY was received by the Board and granted, Saratoga Rural Line B-109 Al, County Road R.W. #5645. A copy of the plat was placed on file.

CASPER - LEO ROAD AND HANNA - LEO ROAD: A motion was made, seconded and carried whereby the following resolution was adopted.

R E S O L U T I O N

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Carbon, is desirous of taking advantage of the provisions of Chapter 99, and/or Chapter 118, Session Laws of Wyoming, 1951, by cooperating with the State Highway Commission of Wyoming in the improvement of a county road, the location and extent of which is as follows:

Section I: On the Casper - Leo Road, South from the Natrona-Carbon line for approximately 3 miles.

Section II: On the Hanna - Leo Road, North from Hanna for approximately 2½ miles.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by said Board:

THAT the Board enter into a written agreement with said Commission covering said improvement in accordance with a contract therefor, now submitted to said Board by said Commission, which agreement is hereby approved and ordered filed in the office of the County Clerk of said county; that the chairman of said Board and the County Clerk of said county be, and they are hereby authorized and directed to execute said contract on behalf of said Board.

SARATOGA*TEN MILE ROAD NO. 504, the Board again post-poned action on the above road until June 3, 1964, due to the absence of W. C. Condict.

SPRING CREEK COUNTY ROAD NO 385: On April 8, 1964 the Board declared the above road be established. On April 24, 1964 the town of Saratoga, a municipal corporation, filed the following petition in the District Court, Civil Case No. 8695; WHEREFORE, the petitioner prays:

1. That the Court set a time and place for hearing to determine the question of necessity of the proposed route of said road; and,

2. That the Court make a determination that it is not necessary to locate and establish said road on a route traversing the lots and blocks of the Plaintiff.

Mitchell stating that there is no public necessity or reason for the location of the said Cow Creek Road, County Road No. 303, across the lands of the plaintiffs in said Section 21, Township 16 North, Range 83 West, 6th P.M. The Board decided to postpone any action pending further investigation of the proposed road.
