COMMISSIONERS PROCEEDINGS

SPECIAL MEETING

John Orton, Chairman and Commissioner John Niland met in Special Session at 2:00 P.M. to consider petitions received by the closing of the Holmes-French road by Millicent Sanger. The signatures of 500 persons were received indicating their protest and objections to this action.

A motion was made by Commissioner Niland, seconded and carried whereby the following notice was sent to Millicent Sanger, et al and a resolution adopted, to wit:

RESOLUTION

HOLMES-FRENCH ROAD

WHEREAS the Board of the County Commissioners of Carbon County has instructed John V. Crow, County Attorney to inform you of the reason for the board action regarding the Holmes-French Road on your property in view of your statement to the Daily Times, and

WHEREAS, at the time the Holmes-French road was closed by you, your written instructions to the guard at the gate were to exclude everyone except Forest Service personel and officers from the Sheriff's Office. However, even if your gate were raised solely to induce professional fishermen to contribute \$5.00 per trip toward the maintenance of the road, as you have suggested, the County cannot use public money and property to maintain a road and have you dictate who can pass over it. A road is either public, as claimed by the County, or private as you claim, it cannot be both.

AND WHEREAS since at the present time, you and everyone else who travels to your ranch and the North Platte River can reach the destination without passing over the Holmes-French road west of the river, the County must not use further money and property on the portion you claim control over, and

NOW, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS THAT the County remains ready and willing to include all of the Holmes-French road in the County public road system and resume its maintenance at any time you desire it done. In the meantime, the law will not permit us to do otherwise than we have advised you. We must use our property only in places where the public can have the benefit of it, without unnecessary interference or hazard occasioned by private interests.

Thereupon the Board adjourned.

UNION PACIFIC RAILROAD COMPANY EXTENSION RIDERS ON AGREEMENTS NO. L519 & L520 TO EXPIRE JUNE 30, 1967 were approved by the Board and a motion was made by Niland, seconded by Salisbury and carried whereby the following resolution was adopted.

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, UNION PACIFIC RAILROAD COMPANY has tendered to the COUNTY OF CARBON, State of Wyoming, an agreement extending to and including June 30, 1967, the term of contract dated March 13, 1964, covering lease of premises, near Hanna, shop and a roadway to gain access to said site; said agreement being identified as Railroad Company's C. D. No. 47777-A; and 47777-L-A; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of County of Carbon, State of Wyoming has said proposed agreement before it and has given it careful review and consideration; and

WHEREAS, it is considered that the best interests of said County of Carbon, State of Wyoming, will be subserved by the acceptance of said agreement;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF COUNTY OF CARBON, STATE OF WYOMING:

That the terms of the agreement submitted by Union Pacific Railroad Company as aforesaid be and the same hereby are accepted in behalf of County of Carbon, State of Wyoming;

That the Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners of said County hereby is authorized, empowered and directed to execute said agreement on behalf of said County, and that the County Clerk hereby is authorized and directed to attest said agreement and to attach to each duplicate original of said agreement a certified copy of this resolution.
