REGULAR MEETING

October 6, 1965

COUNTY SALES TAX:

A motion was made, seconded and carried whereby the following resolution was adopted.

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, a Resolution was passed on October 6, 1965 by the Board of County Commissioners of Carbon County, Wyoming that the Board of County Commissioners shall submit to the people of Carbon County, Wyoming at a special election therefor the question of authorizing said County of Carbon to impose an Excise Tax of $\frac{1}{2}$ of 1% upon retail sales of tangible personal property and other transactions as set forth in Section 39-291, Wyoming Statutes, 1957, as amended, made within said Carbon County, Wyoming for general revenue, as provided by Chapter 118, Session Laws of Wyoming 1965, and,

WHEREAS, after due consideration of said resolution the Board of County Commissioners of Carbon County, Wyoming, do determine that such question should be submitted to the electors of Carbon County, Wyoming, at the direction and under the supervision of said Board of County Commissioners of said County.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED; that the proposition to impose an Excise Tax of $\frac{1}{2}$ of 1% upon retail sales of tangible personal property and other transactions set forth in Section 39-291, Wyoming Statutes, 1957, as amended, made within such County, said tax to be for the purpose of general revenue, as provided by Chapter 118, Session Laws of Wyoming 1965, shall be submitted to the electors of said Carbon County, Wyoming, at a special election called for such specific purpose on the 9th day of November 1965, in the manner and form provided by law.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED; that the polling places for said election shall be in all districts and precincts presently established in Carbon County, Wyoming, except District 2, Precinct 2 (the Old Court House Precinct) this polling place will be the basement floor of the Jeffrey Center. Hanna voting precinct will be in the Love Dance Hall instead

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED; that a notice of said election shall be given by publication in the Daily of Community Hall Times, the newspaper of legal circulation within and for the County of Carbon, State of Wyoming, and that said notice shall be published once weekly for a 30 day period prior to the date of the election. At such election the ballot shall contain the words "FOR THE COUNTY SALES TAX" and "AGAINST THE COUNTY SALES TAX".

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED; that upon approval of the tax by a majority of the qualified electors casting their ballot, the Board of County Commissioners shall then by ordinance duly passed, impose an Excise Tax upon retail sales of tangible personal property and the other transactions set forth in Section 39-291, Wyoming Statutes, 1957, as amended.

Passed, approved and adopted this 6th day of October 1965.

HOLMES - FRENCH ROAD: A motion was made, seconded and carried whereby the following resolution was adopted:

RESOLUTION

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of the County Commissioners of the County of Carbon, Wyoming, at a regular meeting held at Rawlins, Carbon County, Wyoming, on the 6th day of October, 1965, whereas the said Board of the County Commissioners has heretofore deemed it in the public interest to establish a County highway heretofore described across certain lands owned by the Sanger Ranches and Millicent Sanger, Charles Sanger, Jr., and Katherine Sanger; And

WHEREAS the said Board of the County Commissioners has heretofore on the 7th day of September, 1965, appointed Allen W. Mace, County Surveyor of Carbon County, to act as Viewer and to cause a survey to be made of the said road location; and

WHEREAS the report of the said Viewer and the accurate survey required by the Board has been filed in the office of the County Clerk of this County;

IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the County Clerk shall cause lawful notice of the location of the said highway to be published in the manner prescribed by law, and good and sufficient notice as by law required shall be mailed by the said County Clerk to the owners of the lands across which the described road shall pass.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the said County Clerk shall cause Notice to the said lands owners of a time and place after which objections or claims for damages will not be received by the said County.

HOLMES-FRENCH ROAD: At the July 7, 1965 meeting of the Board of County Commissioners a petition signed by approximately 500 residents of Carbon County was received by the Board requesting access through the lands owned by Sanger Ranches through which this road traverses. On October 6, 1965 a motion was made, seconded and carried whereby the Board adopted the following resolution to publish Notice of Location of Public Road.

RESOLUTION
NOTICE OF LOCATION OF PUBLIC ROAD

TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN: The Board of County Commissioners of Carbon County, Wyoming, have decided to locate a road to be known as the Holmes-French Road, Carbon County Road No. 660.

All that portion of Sections 27, 28, 34, and 35, Township 15 N., Range 82 W., of the 6th P.M., Wyoming, lying between parallel right of way lines 100 feet apart being 50 feet on each side when measured at right angles or radially to the following described survey line of road;

Beginning at a point on the North-South center line of Section 28, said Township and Range, from which the North one-quarter corner thereof bears S. a distance of 1080.2 feet, said point also being in the center of an existing road, 2½ Feet Southeast from the center of an existing cattle guard, and monumented by a 12' spike;

thence S. 61° 45' E., a distance of 678.5 feet to a point;

thence S. 55° 02' E., a distance of 3616.4 feet to a point;

thence S. 72° 54' E., a distance of 1199.9 feet to a point;

thence S. 55° 12' E., a distance of 1221.2 feet to a point of beginning of a 1° and 00' circular curve to the right, the radius of which is 5729.65 feet;

thence along said curve through a central angle of 6° 45' a distance of 645.0 feet to the point of ending of said curve;

thence S. 48° 27' E., a distance of 98.2 feet the point of beginning of a 6° 00' circular curve to the right, the radius of which is 955.37 feet;

Thence along said curve through a central angle of 20° 39' a distance of 344.2 feet to the point of ending of said curve;

thence S. 27° 48' E., a distance of 233.3 feet to a point;

thence S. 49° 11' E., a distance of 720.8 feet to a point;

thence S. 43° 40' E., a distance of 450.3 feet to the point of beginning of a 4° 00' curve to the right, the radius of which is 1432.69 feet;

thence along said curve through a central angle of 14° 13' a distance of 355.4 feet to the point of ending of said curve;

thence S. 29° 27' E., a distance of 658.1 feet to a point;

thence S., 41° 06' E., a distance of 934.3 feet to a point;

thence S. 33° 44' E., a distance of 1016.0 feet to a point;

thence S. 43° 01' E., a distance of 1614.7 feet to the point of beginning of a 10° circular curve to the left, the radius of which is 573.69 feet;

thence along said curve through a central angle of 37° 36' a distance of 376.0 feet to the point of ending of said curve;

thence S. 80° 37' E., a distance of 302.1 feet to a point;

Thence S. 67° 36' E., a distance of 963.6 feet to the point of beginning of a 16° 00' curve, the radius of which is 359.26 feet;

thence along said curve through a central angle of 32° 56' a distance of 205.8 feet to the point of ending of said curve;

thence N. 79° 28' E., a distance of 656.8 feet to a point;

thence N. 52° 48' E., a distance of 468.3 feet to the point of termination of said center line of the road, said point of termination being on the East line of Section 35 said Township and Range, and bearing N. a distance of 465 feet from the SE corner of said Section 35.

The length of the heretofore described road is 3.17 miles.

The area of the heretofore described road is 38.47 acres.

The proposed location and width of right of way required are set forth in detail on a map on file with the County Clerk and may be examined at his office.

Any land owner or interested party desiring to raise any question with respect to the necessity of the taking of the land for road purposes shall do so by filing, within thirty days after the last publication of this notice, a petition in the District Court of the county in which the land is located. If no petition to raise the question of necessity is filed within the said thirty day period, the necessity shall be presumed and the question cannot later be raised.

All other objections thereto or claims for damages by reason thereof must be filed in writing with the County Clerk of said county before noon on the 8th day of December, A.D., 1965, or such road will be established without reference to such objections or claims for damages.
