ELK MOUNTAIN WATER BOND ELECTION.

Commissioner John Orton introduced and moved the adoption of the following resolution, which was thereupon read in full and is as follows:

R E S O L U T I O N

WHEREAS, the Town Clerk of the Town of Elk Mountain, in the County of Carbon and State of Wyoming, has transmitted a certified copy of an ordinance adopted and approved by the Council of the Town of Elk Mountain on the 1st day of November, 1965, to the County Clerk for the Board of County Commissioners of Carbon County; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has determined, and does hereby determine, that it is necessary and for the best interests of the Town of Elk Mountain, and the County, and its inhabitants, to provide for the authorization of a bonded indebtedness by the Town of Elk Mountain in the aggregate principal amount of \$60,000.00, or so much thereof as may be necessary, for the purpose of supplying water to the Town by constructing a municipal water works system.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF CARBON COUNTY, STATE OF WYOMING:

Section 1. That all action heretofore taken by the Town Council of the Town of Elk Mountain, the officers thereof, and the officers of Carbon County, directed toward supplying water to the Town by construction a municipal water works system, and toward submitting the question of issuing the negotiable, coupon, general obligation bonds of said Town for that purpose be, and the same hereby is, ratified, approved and confirmed, including, without limiting the generality of the foregoing, the adoption by said Town Council of said ordinance on the 1st day of November, 1965, and all action taken pursuant thereto.

Section 2. That the County Clerk shall give notice of the action hereby taken by transmitting to the Clerk of said Town of Elk Mountain, Wyoming, for said Town Council, a certified copy of this resolution.

Section 3. That the officers of the County of Carbon be, and they hereby are, authorized and directed to take all action necessary or appropriate to effectuate the provisions of this resolution and Ordinance No. 30, Series 1965, passed and adopted on the 1st day of November, 1965, by the Town Council of the Town of Elk Mountain, Wyoming.


Section 4. That all resolutions or parts thereof in conflict with this resolution are hereby repealed.

Section 5. That if any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this resolution shall for any reason be held to be invalid or unenforceable, the invalidity or unenforceability of such section, paragraph, clause or provision shall not affect any of the remaining provisions of this resolution.


Section 6. That by reason of the fact that said Town is not properly or adequately supplied with the above-designated facility, it is hereby declared that an emergency exists, that this resolution is necessary to the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and that it shall be in full force and effect immediately after its adoption and approval.

Section 7. That this resolution shall be entered on record in the minute book of the Board of County Commissioners, and the County Clerk is authorized and directed to carry out the provisions hereof.

A majority of the members of the Board of County Commissioners having voted in favor of said motion, the Chairman declared said motion carried, and the resolution duly passed and adopted.

On motion duly made, seconded and adopted, it was ordered that said resolution be approved and authenticated by the signatures of the Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners and the County Clerk of Carbon County, and recorded in the records of said resolution should be transmitted by said County Clerk to the Clerk of the Said Town of Elk Mountain, Wyoming, for the Town Council thereof.

Thereupon the Board adjourned until the following day.
