


November 10, 1965

HOLMES - FRENCH ROAD CARBON COUNTY ROAD NO. 660. The Board of Commissioners received a claim for damages on December 8, 1965 in the amount of \$59,617.50 from Charles A. Sanger, Kathryn L. Sanger, Millicent Sanger, & Sanger Ranches, Inc. in compliance with the Notice of Location of Public Road published in the Rawlins Daily Times on October 21, 28 and November 4, 1965 and the claim for damages was received in writing by the County Clerk on or before noon on the 8th day of December, 1965.


