Josephine Danford, Dixon, Wyoming - Treasurer of Reader Cemetery District 6-19-67 to 6-19-68 \$3000.00.



HOSPITAL BOARD: The Board reappointed A. D. Fulton as a member of the Hospital Board commencing 7-11-67, term expiring 7-11-72.


