GETTY OIL COMPANY: The Board met with R. Lauren Moran and Don Nichols of the Getty Oil Company to discuss the sale of Public Lands under the provisions of the Public Land Sale Act of 1964, (78 Stat. 988, 43 USCA Sec. 1421 et Seq.)

The Commissioners entered into a contract between the Board of County Commissioners of Carbon County, Wyo., and the Getty Oil Company, a corporation with offices at Los Angeles, Cal. (a copy being on file in the office of the County Clerk, Rawlins, Wyo.), to assist in presenting to the Bureau of Land Management, a petition for the sale of Public Lands under this act, which would be for the best interests of Carbon County, Wyo.

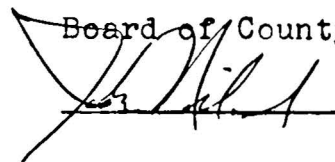
