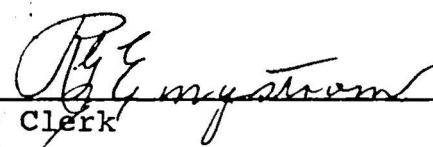
THE BOARD approved the J. P. bond of James O. Young in the amount of \$5000.00.

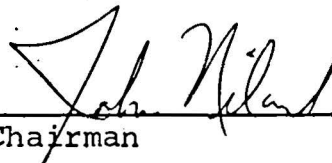
THE BOARD executed a memorandum of understanding between the Wyoming State Highway Department and Carbon County, Wyoming.
