RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF CARBON COUNTY, WYOMING RELATIVE TO PLANNING COOPERATION WITH THE CITY OF RAWLINS, WYOMING.

WHEREAS, THE Carbon County and Rawlins City Planning commissions intend to develop a city and county-wide comprehensive planning program; and,

WHEREAS, said planning program will mutually benefit incorporated areas as well as unincorporated county areas; and

WHEREAS, the effectiveness of said program depends on the cooperative attitude of all county residents and political jurisdictions;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the County Commissioners of Carbon County hereby endorses the proposed joint planning efforts of the Carbon County and Rawlins City Planning commissions and will cooperate fully to coordinate the planning objectives.

THAT, the County Commissioners of Carbon County will provide \$9,317 for its portion of the one-third share of the City-County planning program. Said funds will be available July 1 of each year as follows:

Fiscal year 1969-1970 \$2500 -- 1970-1971 \$3200-- 1971-1972 \$3617. Total \$9317.00




