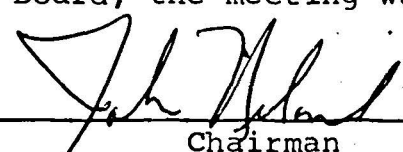

Section 2 of said proceedings to be as follows:

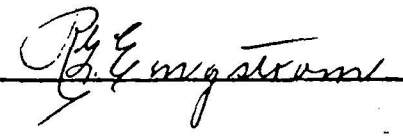
SECTION 2: That said Bonds shall be dated as of April 1, 1971 and shall consist of 335 Bonds in Denominations of \$1000.00 each.
