R E S O L U T I O N

WHEREAS, at a special bond election of the qualified electors of Carbon County, Wyoming, held on Tuesday, the 29th day of December, 1970, there was submitted to such electors the question of issuing general obligation Hospital Bonds of the County in the principal amount of \$335,000, for the purpose of completing the construction and equipping of the County Memorial Hospital in Rawlins, Wyoming; and



THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF CARBON COUNTY, WYOMING:


