NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners that the County budget, as so revised and altered, be adopted as the official county budget for the 1972-1973 fiscal year ending June 30, 1973.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the following appropriations be made for the 1972-1973 fiscal year ending June 30, 1973, and that the expenditures of each officer, department or spending agency be limited to the amount herein appropriated.


