Commissioners Proceedings

Special Meeting

The Board of County Commissioners met at 9:00 A. M. John Niland, Chairman and Gene T. McMillen present, John Orton absent.

LITTLE SNAKE RIVER MUSEUM DISTRICT.

The motion was made by McMillen seconded by Niland where by the following Resolution was adopted, to wit:

R E S O L U T I O N

WHEREAS, Petition for Establishment of Special Museum District to be known as the Little Snake River Museum District has been presented and filed with the Board of County Commissioners, Carbon County, Wyoming; and

WHEREAS, public hearing was convened on said Petition in the Commissioners Room, Courthouse Bldg., Rawlins, Wyoming, on Thursday, November 9, 1972 at 10:00 o'clock A. M; and

WHEREAS, at said public hearing any person could appear and be heard concerning any and all matters affecting the creation of said Little Snake River Museum District; and

WHEREAS, there being no protestants appearing at said public hearing; and

WHEREAS, written protests could be filed through Decemter '11, 1972, the date under which the written/period would expire; and protests

WHEREAS, no writted protests have been filed and Section 18-330.8, (c) provides that the Board of County Commissioners shall order an election to be held within sixty (60) days after the expiration of the said 30 day written protest period; and

WHEREAS, at said election the question of the organization and establishment of said Little Snake River Museum District shall be voted upon by the qualified property and non property owners residing within said proposed district; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners have this dates met in special session for the purpose of setting the time and place and legal notice of said election.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that a special election shall be held upon the question of the organization and establish ment of a special museum district to be known as the LITTLE SNAKE RIVER MUSEUM DISTRICT and which proposed district to be voted upon shall be composed of the following described lands bounded as follows:

Beginning at the Southeast corner of Township 12 North, Range 87 West which point is the Wyoming-Colorado boundary; Thence, North along the Range line between Ranges 86 West and 87 West to the Northeast corner of Township 16 North, Range 87 West; Thence, West along the Township line between Townships 16 and 17 North to the Southeast corner of Township 17 North, Range 91 West; Thence, North along the Range linebetween Ranges 90 West and 91 West to the Sweetwater County line; Thence, West along the Carbon-Sweetwater County line to the northwest corner of Township 19North, Range 93 West (The Northewsterly corner of Carbon County, Wyoming;) Thence, South along the Carbon-Sweetwater County line to the Wyoming-Colorado State line; Thence, East along the Wyoming-Colorado State line to the place of beginning.

The place of election whall be the PARISH HOUSE at DIXON, WYOMING; the date of election is Tuesday, January 9, 1973 the time of election is from 9:00 o'clock A.M. to 7:00 P.M. at said date and place. Separate ballots shall be preapred for property owners and non property owners. And legal publication shall be made once weekly for four (4) consecutive weeks preceding the day of election in ~~the Snake River Press and~~ The Rawlins Daily Times.
