TAX LEVY MEETING.

The Board of Commissioners met August 1, 1973 at 9:00 A. M. all members present, John Niland, Chairman, together with County Assessor, R. A. Hakala, for the purpose of fixing tax levies for and within Carbon County for the year 1973-1974 in compliance with Chapter 39-89 Wyoming Statutes, 1957.

Having received from the State Board of Equalization notice that the assessed valuation of Carbon County for the year 1973-1974 has been found to be \$85,965,892, the County Assessor advised the Board of the assessed valuation of each of the various municipalities and school districts within the County, and the Board proceeded to fix levies upon the assessed property of Carbon County for the year 1973-1974 as follows:
