THE KENNEDAY PEAK RECREATIONAL ROAD. The Board entered into an agreement with the Wyoming Highway Department for planning and preliminary engineering to determine corridor location.

A motion was made by McMillen, seconded by Orton and unanimously carried where by the following resolution was adopted.

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Carbon is desirous of taking advantage of the provisions of Section 24-38, 24-68 and 24-69, W.S. 1957, by cooperating with the State Highway Commission of Wyoming in the construction and /or the improvement of a county road, the extent and location of work which is as follows: Planning and preliminary engineering to determine corridor location for the Kenneday Peak Recreational Road beginning on the Pass Creek Road to a point on the north line of Section 5, T.18,R 81 W. extending southerly and southwesterly for approximately 15.0 miles to a junction with the Ryan Park Road in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 33, T17N, R 82W.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by said Board: THAT the Board enter into a written agreement with said Commission covering said construction and/ or improvement in accordance with a contract therefor, now submitted to said Board by said Commission, which agreement is hereby approved and ordered filed in the office of the County Clerk of said county; that the chairman of said Board and the County Clerk of said county be, and they are hereby authorized and directed to execute said contract on behalf of said Board.

I, the undersigned, Clerk of Carbon Count, State of Wyoming, do hereby certify that at a legal meeting of the Board of County Commissioners at which a quorum was present, said Board adopted a resolution of which the foregoing is a full, true and complete copy.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Carbon County, Wyoming, a body politic and corporate, are duly assembled in a regular and lawful meeting at the Courthouse Bldg., Rawlins, Carbon County, Wyoming this 7th day of November, 1973; and

WHEREAS, representatives of the uranium industry have advised the Board of critical shortage of propane gas to carry on uranium milling operations in Shirley Basin, Carbon County, Wyoming; and

WHEREAS, the uranium industry in Carbon County, Wyoming, has grown to be of substantial importance in its economy; and

WHEREAS, recent emergency measures have curtained delivery of propane gas to the uranium industry in Shirley Basin, Carbon County, Wyoming; and

WHEREAS, the uranium industry in Shirley Basin plays a vital role in the economic well being of Carbon County, Wyoming, and the national security of this Nation; and

WHEREAS, said uranium industry is presently totally dependent on propane gas for normal operations; and

WHEREAS, said normal operations in Carbon County, Wyoming, have now come to a virtual stand-still.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the restrictions of propane gas to the uranium industry now in effect which have terminated delivery of propane gas to the Shirley Basin, Carbon County, Wyoming area be relaxed to the extent that continuous operations can be maintained until alternate fuel systems can be installed.
