22.1-394. Failure to file statement: A candidate who failed to file, within the time required, a full and complete itemized statement of receipts and expenditures or who violates the provisions of section 221-389 of the statutes by exceeding the allowed maximum of expenditures is guilty of a misdemeanor, and no such candidate shall receive a certificate of nomination, or election, nor shall he enter upon the duties of the office, as the case may be, and a vacancy shall exist.
