SARATOGA HISTORICAL AND CULTURAL ASSOCIATION, INC. Mrs. Elva Evans and Mrs. Mimi Gilman presented to the Commissioners a plan to acquire the Hotel Wolf, a designated Historic Site. In making application for funds under the Historic Preservation Act for the acquisition and restoration of this Site, it would be necessary for the Association to demonstrate that it has support from local units of government as well as the many individuals and other organizations from whom interest has been indicated.

RAWLINS-CARBON COUNTY REGIONAL PLANNING COMMISSION. The following reports were submitted: A Housing Analysis for Carbon County, June 1975, A Recreation Plan (2nd Year), Carbon County, June 1975, a Transportation Study for Carbon County, June, 1975 and a map of the Carbon County-BLM Road Systems.

SHERIFF'S OFFICE. A motion was made by Lemich, seconded by Glode and carried to allow for an increase of the board of prisoners to \$3.00 per day per prisoner as of July 1, 1975. A contract was signed with Hitchcock & Hitchcock, Architects, for architectural services for an addition to the Courthouse.


