JUSTICE PEACE-DISTRICT No. 2. A motion was made by Orton, seconded by Glode that Edna Jackson be appointed Justice of the Peace at a salary of \$500.00 per month.

A motion was made by Orton, seconded by Glode and carried whereby the following resolution was adopted:

R E S O L U T I O N

WHEREAS, the sheep industry is a basic and substantial industry in Carbon county, Wyoming, and

WHEREAS, predatory animals are inflicting serious economic loss to the sheep industry in said county, and

WHEREAS, said losses are of such magnitude as to be cause for proclamation of Carbon County, Wyoming, as a disaster area.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Carbon County, Wyoming, lawfully convened at a regular meeting in the Commissioners' Chambers, Courthouse Bldg., Rawlins, Wyoming, that Carbon County, Wyoming, be, and

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it is hereby declared a disaster area by reason of serious economic losses inflicted upon the sheep industry of Carbon County, Wyoming.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution be set forth at length in the official minutes of this Board and be made a matter of public record.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County Clerk is hereby ordered to forward a certified copy of this Resolution to the Governor of the State of Wyoming and to each member of our Congressional delegation requesting such financial assistance as may be available in behalf of the sheep industry of Carbon County, Wyoming.

R E S O L U T I O N

WHEREAS, Sage Creek and Medicine Bow River in Carbon County, Wyoming, are tributaries of the North Platte River; and

WHEREAS, a serious problem of silt and pollution from said streams exists and remedial measures should be undertaken as soon as possible by the proper authorities; and

WHEREAS, The Board of County Commissioners of Carbon County, Wyoming, deems it advisable to make said silting and pollution problem in the North Platte River in Carbon County, Wyoming, a matter of public record.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Governor and the State Engineer of the State of Wyoming be formally notified and informed of the serious silting and pollution problem of the North Platte River in Carbon County, Wyoming, by the Sage Creek and Medicine Bow River.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that said Board request that remedial action be undertaken as soon as possible by the proper agency within the State of Wyoming.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County Clerk of Carbon County, Wyoming, forthwith mail copies of this Resolution to the Governor and State Engineer of the State of Wyoming.
